Homilies on today's feast of the Holy Trinity are often as mysterious as the mystery of the Trinity itself. But Pope Francis has offered these practical reflections:

"The feast of the Most Holy Trinity invites us to a gracious sharing in our everyday relationships in our families, friends, parishioners, and work colleagues."

"Celebrating the mystery of three Gods in one person is an invitation for us to commit to enriching our everyday relationships by promoting communion, consolation, and compassion."

"God is a 'family' of three Persons who love each other so much they form a single unit."

"The 'Divine Family' is not closed in on itself, but is open, communicating itself in creation and in history, and has entered into our world to call everyone to a similar generosity."

"We were created in the image and likeness of the God-communion which calls us to see ourselves as relational beings, and to live our interpersonal relationships in reciprocal love."

"In this mission, we are sustained by the strength which the Holy Spirit gives us: this Spirit can cure our human weaknesses of injustice, oppression, hate, and greed."

"These are concrete occasions offered to us to build ever more humanly rich relationships, capable of reciprocal respect and selfless love."

"The relationship of the persons of the Trinity is revealed in Christ fulfilling his Father's plan through his death and resurrection then sending the Holy Spirit to continue his mission."

"The Holy Spirit helps us in understanding the many things which Jesus taught by guiding us in new life situations, helping us to keep our gaze on Jesus, with open hearts to future events."

"This guidance of the Holy Spirit helps us to walk in history, firmly rooted in the Gospel, and with dynamic fidelity to the traditions and customs of our faith."

"The mystery of the Trinity also speaks to us about our relationship with the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, which is our inner life of grace."

"Through Baptism the Holy Spirit has placed in our heart the life of God, who is the communion of love. God is love. The triune God is love in union and communion."

"Mary, the mirror of the love of the Trinity, can renew our faith in the Trinitarian Mystery, and animate us with attitudes of love and unity in our daily choices."

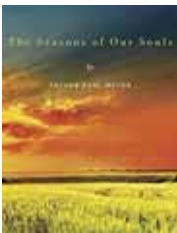

To obtain a plenary indulgence during a pilgrimage to a basilica, one must participate in any sacred rite or recite the Lord's Prayer or the profession of faith while there, then go to Confession and Communion and pray for the intention of the pope.
