Marriage in Heaven

"At the resurrection whose wife will she be?" That was the trick question in today's gospel about a woman with seven husbands. It was answered implicitly by Shakespeare since the same question might be asked not only of multiple marriages but also of a couple faithfully married for many years. They have been together through Shakespeare's seven stages of life.

"All the world's a stage, and one man in his time plays many parts. At first the infant, mewling and puking in his nurse's arms. Then the whining school-boy creeping like a snail unwillingly to school. Then the lover sighing a ballad to his beloved. Next a soldier jealous in honor, brave in battle. And then the justice in fair round belly and beard of formal cut. The sixth age shifts to a leaner form with spectacles on nose, his voice now pipes and whistles. Last scene of all is second childishness without teeth, without eyes, without all."

Shakespeare suggests that a couple who had been faithfully married for many years has been together through those seven stages of life. Such a woman has had seven husbands: The groom beside her at the altar. The father of their first child. The worker providing for his family. The husband who built their home. The father who danced at his daughter's wedding. The grandfather who doted on their children's children. The frail senior of fading strength.

One man, seven husbands. At the resurrection, whose wife will she be? Whose husband will he be? Physically, none of them; spiritually, all of them.

This challenging gospel reminds us that marriage is much more than the physical. It is personal, psychological, and spiritual. And the spirit is the only dimension that lasts. A physical relationship is ruinous without first establishing a stable communion of lives. What endures not only in the next life but through the difficulties of this life is not the physical but the personal spiritual bond. That union of souls should be the first priority of couples preparing for, and those living out, a marriage commitment,

"Whose wife will she be. All seven had married her?" What is of death will end; what is of life will be transformed. What is selfish will vanish; what is of love will endure. What is of sin will be redeemed; what is of God will be revealed. "God is the God of the living, not of the dead, for to him all are alive."

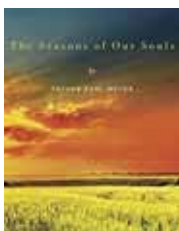

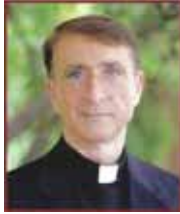
