"I am spiritual but not religious." One hears that often today. To be spiritual but not religious is like being hungry and not eating. The challenge of Christ to the "spiritual but not religious" is today's gospel verse, "Where two or three are gathered in my name there am I in their midst." A desire for the spiritual yet rejecting religion may come from a misunderstanding of Christian worship or worship poorly done. Catholics do not simply attend Mass, we participate in Mass. We respond to the prayers and the readings, join in the singing and the responses, sharing the Eucharist and peace with each other.

At a parish Mass there is a spiritual as well as a psychological group dynamic. By assembling in his name, we make the Lord present among us. "Where two or three are gathered in my name there am I in their midst." That is the reason why you cannot attend Mass, or receive any of the Sacraments on television, over the telephone, or on-line.



When the faithful assemble for the celebration of the Eucharist, the Lord is present in three ways: in Eucharist, in Scripture, and in the assembly. He is bodily present in the Eucharist, and we receive the Body and Blood of Christ in Holy Communion. This bodily presence of Christ is the unique and essential aspect of the Eucharist.

The Lord is also present in the proclamation of the Scriptures. Reading the Word of God makes the Word of God present to the assembly. The Lord is present in the proclamation of his Word to his people.

The third presence of the Lord, the focus of today's gospel, is effected by the gathering of the faithful. "Where two or three gathered in my name, there am I in their midst." The Lord is made present by each member of the congregation as they assemble in His name. Gathering in his name makes the Lord present to those so assembled.



This presence of the Lord in the assembly of the faithful is vital in our age and is the antidote to the mentality of spiritual but not religious. One of the negative characteristics of our age is isolation which can erode trust and faith. Many today are not concerned whether their attendance at church will benefit others, or even if it will give glory to God. They ask only, "What will I get out of it?" Aptly named the "me" generation.

At a Eucharistic assembly, the presence of each one makes Christ present to all, and the absence of any one lessens the presence of Christ for others. We are the Body of Christ. Our greatest experience of this is when we assemble for the Eucharist. "Where two or three are gathered in my name, there am I in their midst."

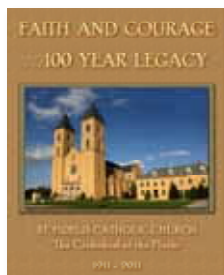

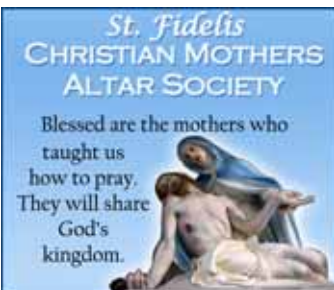

## PLENARY INDULGENCE GIVEN WHEN VISITING A BASILICA

The faithful may obtain a plenary indulgence by visiting a minor basilica. An indulgence is a remission before God of the temporal punishment for a previously forgiven sin. To obtain a plenary indulgence during a pilgrimage to a basilica, one must participate in any sacred rite or recite the Lord's Prayer or the profession of faith while there, then go to Confession and Communion and pray for the intention of the pope.
