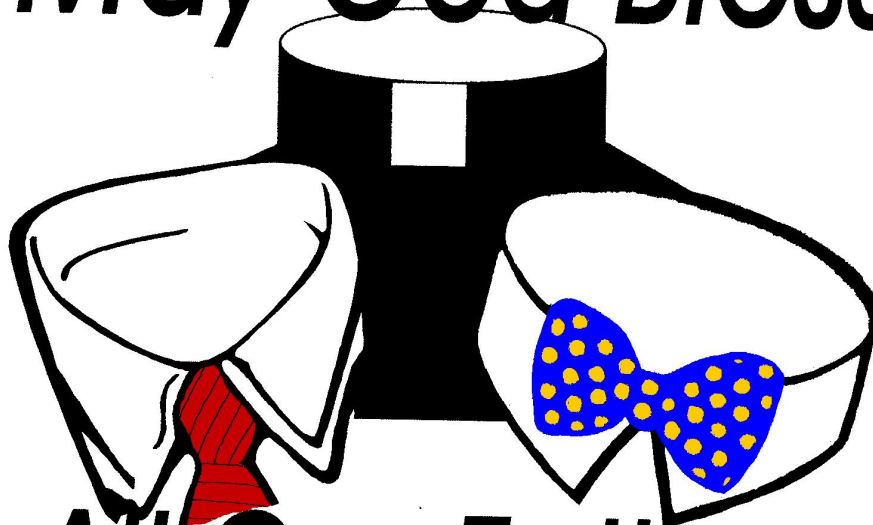

*For your homework, please read **Gospel of John, chapter 6**, called the **Bread of Life Discourse**.*

1. False. Baptism is first. Permanently bound to Christ in Baptism, the Eucharist (Body/Blood) then continues to nourish us. Through the Mass, we unite ourselves with the heavenly liturgy and we anticipate eternal life.
2. True. Christ as victim on Cross, is one and the same as the victim on the altar at Mass, offered through the ministry of priests. Only the manner of offering is different. There is no physical Cross at Mass, but Christ's Body and Blood are present at Mass.
3. True.
4. False. The Eucharist, the sacrament of our salvation accomplished by Christ on the cross, is also a sacrifice of praise in thanksgiving for the work of creation. In the Eucharistic sacrifice, the whole of creation loved by God is presented to our Heavenly Father through the death and the Resurrection of Christ. Through Christ, the Church can offer the sacrifice of praise in thanksgiving for all that God has made good, beautiful, and just in creation and in humanity.
