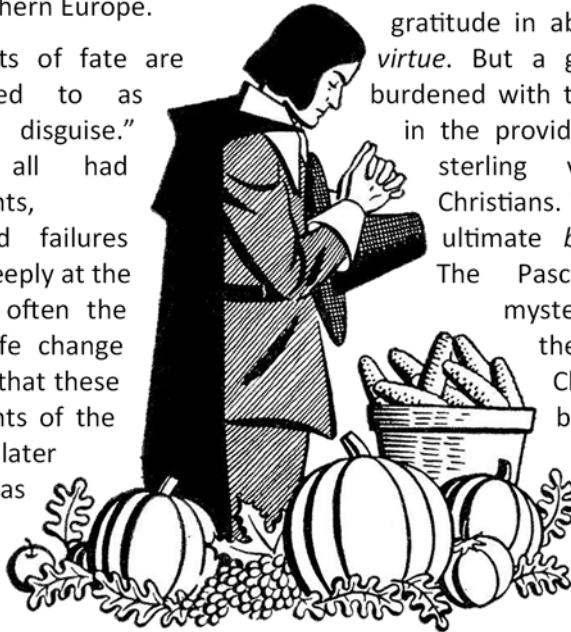

## Blessings in Disguise

General George Patton, disappointed at being passed over for the command to invade Italy wrote in his diary: *"Thanksgiving Day, 1942. I have nothing to be thankful for. So I did not give thanks today."* A few weeks later he was appointed commander of Operation Overlord where he led the allied forces in liberating northern Europe.

Such twists of fate are often referred to as "blessings in disguise." We have all had disappointments, setbacks, and failures that hurt us deeply at the time. But so often the fortunes of life change in such a way that these disappointments of the moment are later seen as blessings. Some might see only a fortunate



coincidence, but in the full picture of our life few would deny the providence of God.

It is easy to be grateful for the evident blessings which enrich our lives: good health, good friends, and good fortune. But to be thankful for the hidden blessings of life challenges even devout Christians. One blessing of aging is a perspective on our life which can see that some disappointments in the past were actually *blessings in disguise*.

This might be especially true of the hidden blessings of faith. Perhaps you were upset by unanswered prayers, moral teachings of the church, changes in the liturgy, even the odd personality of a priest. Yet with the advantage of hindsight, you came to see that many of these were occasions for you to

grow in your faith. A secure faith is a great comfort. But challenges to our faith are opportunities to develop a yet deeper faith.

If you are struggling this Thanksgiving with difficulties of faith, weary of an illness, troubled with uncertain finances, or challenged by a difficult relationship, know that gratitude in abundance is a *cheap virtue*. But a grateful heart when burdened with trials, rooted in trust in the providence of God, is the sterling virtue of faithful Christians. The Crucifixion is the ultimate *blessing in disguise*. The Paschal Mystery, the mystery of the death and the resurrection of Christ, the central belief of our faith, is celebrated in each Eucharist, and the word *Eucharist* means *Thanksgiving*.

A disappointed Patton wrote in his diary: *"Thanksgiving Day, 1942. I have nothing to be thankful for. So I did not give thanks today."* May God grant each of us the grace to see beyond our daily trials to the greater pattern of his providence so that on Thanksgiving Day, 2022, we can write in the diary of our hearts, *"Today I gave thanks."*
