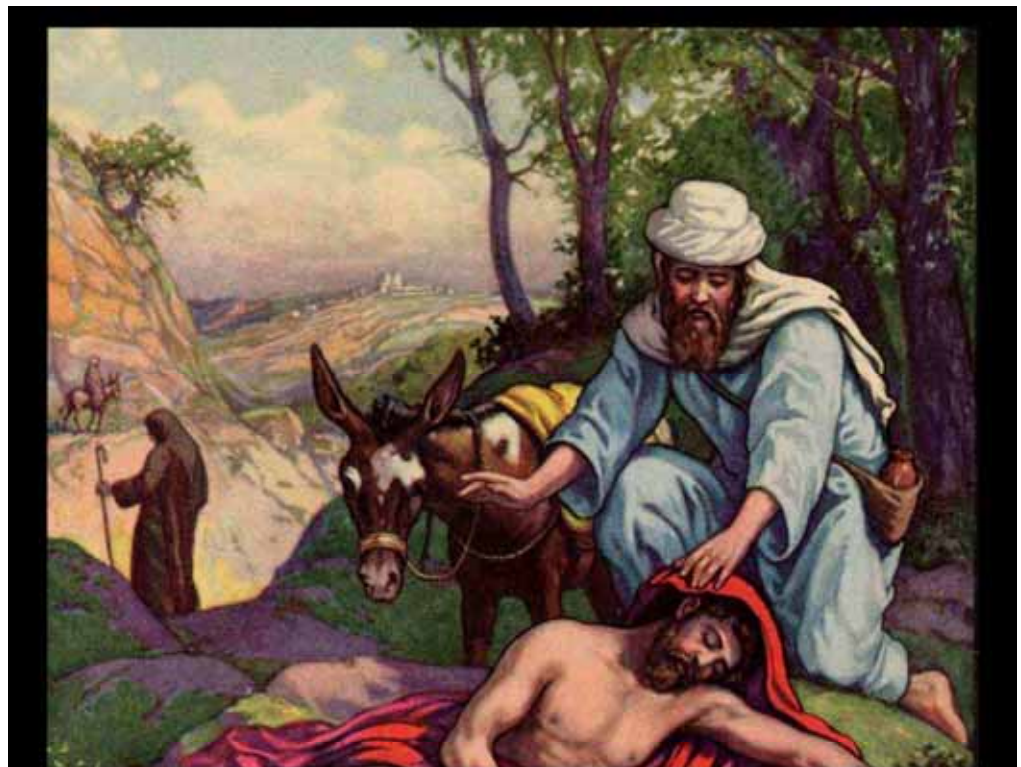

“You shall love the Lord, your God, with all your heart, with all your being, with all your strength, and with all your mind, and your neighbor as yourself.”

Luke 10:25-37



Who is my Neighbor?

An elderly priest was asked why he always answered a question with a question. He replied, "Is that what I do?" He may have learned his technique from Jesus. In the gospels when Jesus was asked a question he often responded with a question.



Today's parable of the Good Samaritan is a timely example. The scribe in this gospel asked Jesus, "Who is my neighbor?" Jesus answered him with a parable ending with this challenging question, "Who was neighbor to the victim of the robber?"

To the audience of Christ this gospel parable of the Good Samaritan was an embarrassing rebuke. While the title *Good Samaritan* is inspiring for us, it was a bitter paradox to the scribe who questioned Christ. The Jews and Samaritans were feuding enemies. As we today might find the term "good terrorist" a contradiction, the audience of Christ found the idea of a good Samaritan offensive.

And that is precisely the point of this parable. The one commonly judged as immoral was precisely the one who was good. The priest and the Levite were presumed to be virtuous, but in fact they did not help. The parable speaks also to our prejudices. We can be blind to goodness in others. If we assume that another can do no good, we miss their virtue. A difficult

child may in fact be a gifted child; a frugal neighbor, a generous benefactor; a silent spouse, a thoughtful partner.

Failure to recognize virtue in others not only denies their goodness, but is often a ploy to avoid the challenge their virtue presents. Perhaps we ignore the goodness of a neighbor, a friend, or a spouse because it might expose our lack of virtue. If I concede that my neighbor is generous, I must face my selfishness. If I admit that my friend is tolerant, then I must examine my prejudices. If I acknowledge that my spouse is patient with my faults, I am challenged to be understanding in return.

The good Samaritan did not ask, "Does the victim deserve help?" But, "Does he need help?" I am not to ask if the needy are worthy, but rather, "How can I help?" Christian virtue is offering goodness without hope of return. Charity is a gift, not a gift exchange.

Today's gospel answers a question with a question. The scribe was trying to avoid the commandment of Christ to love his neighbor, so he asked, "Who is my neighbor?" Christ answered that question with a more challenging question, "Who is neighbor to the one in need?"
