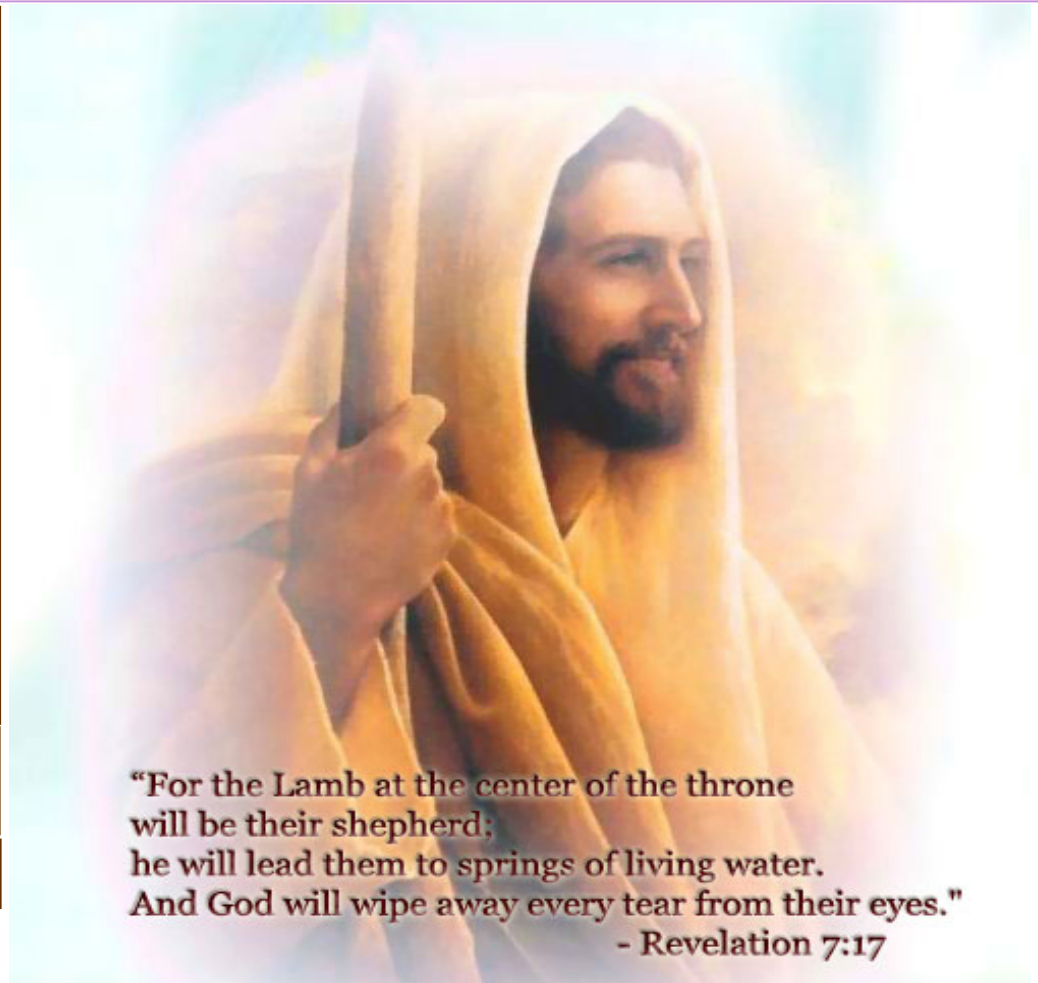

# FRIARS' MIND

It is normal to belong to a specific parish, though one might occasionally go to Mass at another parish on some weekends for particular reasons. We are not to be "roaming Catholics" who have not registered in any parish.

To belong to a parish means that the individual or the family registers with the parish and commits Time, Talent, and Treasure to that parish. Conversely, the pastor and parish staff are committed to provide pastoral care and Sacramental services for all registered parishioners. When children in the family turn 18, they are considered independent adults and should therefore register in a parish as adults--whether their home parish or another one.

Boxes of envelopes are available to individuals or heads of households for their weekly donations to the Sunday collection. This enables the parish to offer a letter indicating their charitable giving. This can also be tracked if the donation is by check. The parish appreciates the unidentified loose cash contributed, but is not able to acknowledge receipt of this.

Christian stewardship is not merely about fund-raising or project-completion. Stewardship is a way of living for ones whole life. Parishioners are called to be generous as God is generous with them. God is the ultimate giver of all good things. Stewardship is a bridge between the outer material world and the inner spiritual world of faith. It is an expression of personal investment in the recipients of the contributions. We support what we value.

Our giving is to be intentional, planned (weekly or monthly), and proportionate to the Time, Talent, and Treasure that we have.

A person or family needs enough money to pay for reasonable expenses. If they have more than this on hand, they can invest in savings, as well as share with those in need. A parish needs enough money to pay reasonable expenses. If the parish has more than this on hand, it can invest in savings, as well as share with those in need.

Please pray and talk about this and allow the Lord to guide your attitude and actions in your life of Stewardship.

## HELP US PRESERVE THE INTEGRITY OF OUR CHURCH

The exterior of our beloved church is in need of repair. This restoration project will help preserve the structure and beauty of our church for generations to come.



Mid-Continental Restoration Co., Inc. will be completing this work. The scope of the project includes:

### Sealant Application to Vertical Joints in Stone Caps & Bands

All vertical head joints between coping stones and stone bands will be cut back and cleaned of any loose or foreign debris. These joints will then be resealed with new sealant, tooled to a neat and uniform appearance, and color-matched as closely as possible to the existing material.

### Tuckpointing Stone Mortar Joints

All mortar joints will be carefully inspected. Any that are found to be void, open, or defective will be repaired. All affected areas will be cleaned to remove any loose residue, and defective joints will be repointed using a non-staining, non-shrinking Type "N" masonry mortar. This mortar will be color-matched and tooled to blend seamlessly with the surrounding joints.

The total estimated cost for this vital work is **\$109,980**. We are asking for your generosity in helping us raise the necessary funds to complete these repairs. No amount is too small, and all donations are deeply appreciated. You can donate by dropping off at the Parish Office or by placing in the collection basket in a **separate envelope labeled "Building Repairs"**.
