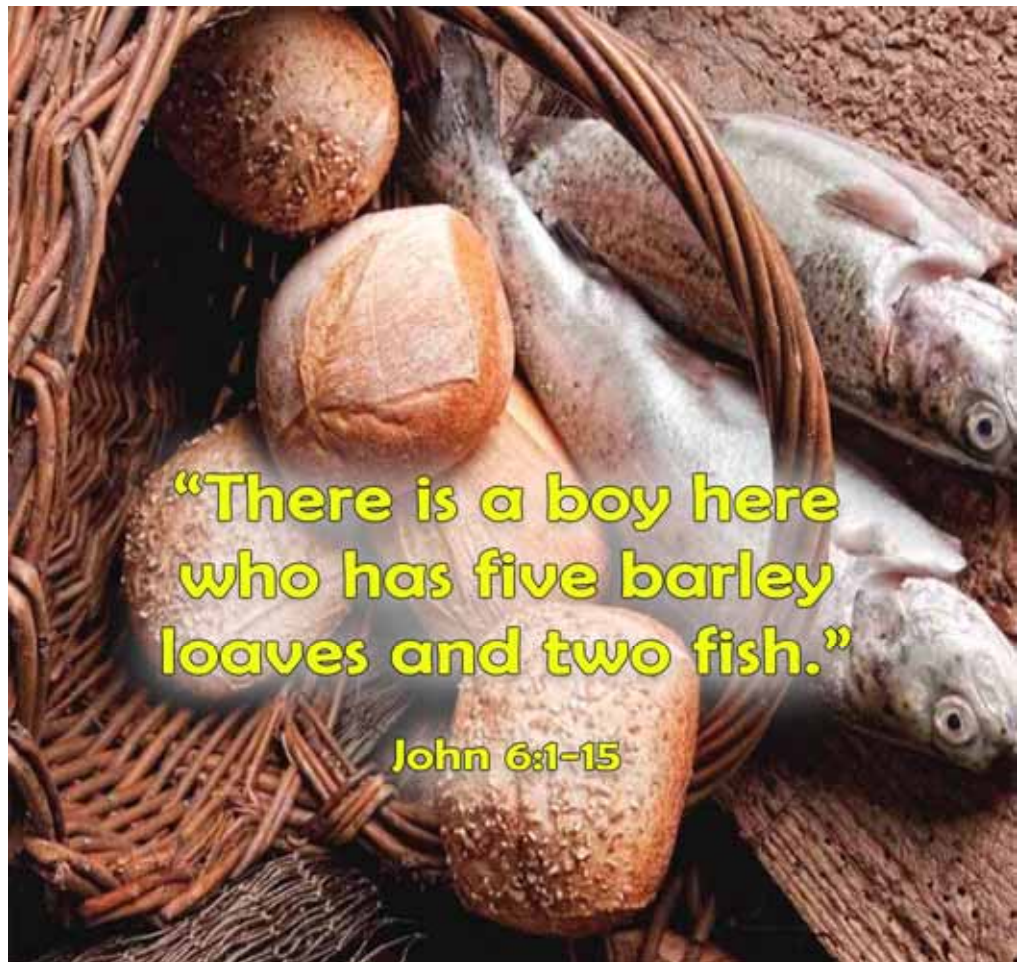

"You're finished already?" the homeowner asked.

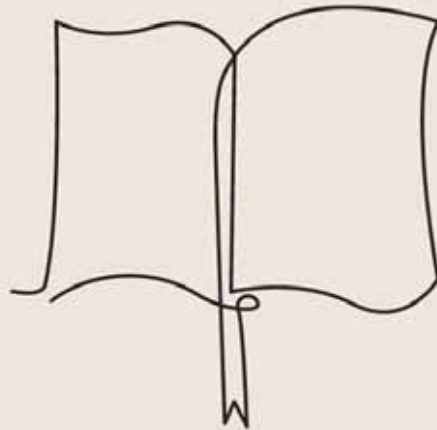
"Yes," the dumb guy answered, "and I had paint left over, so I gave it two coats."
