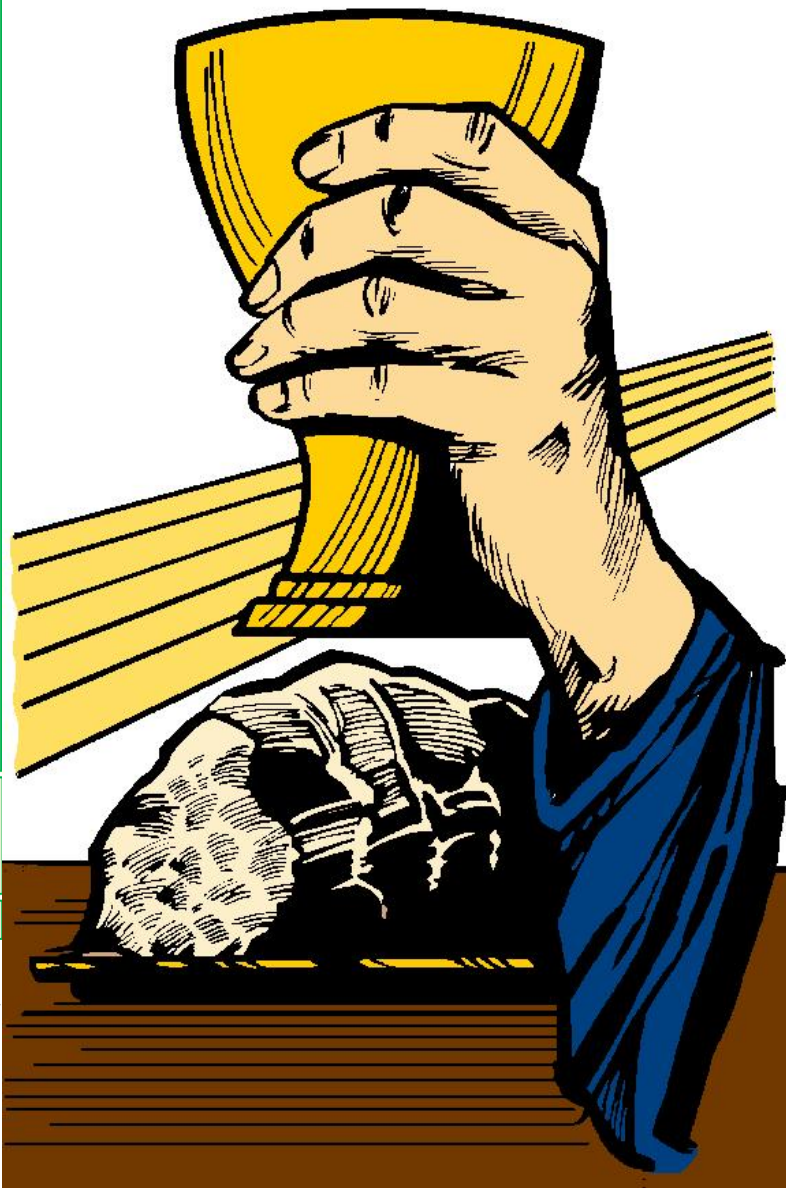

FRIARS' MIND

During hot summer days, some people wish it were cooler. Some people long for warmth in the midst of winter. Perhaps they could ponder this statement by Henry David Thoreau: "I love best to have each thing in its season, doing without it at all other times."

We might be happier if we can appreciate each aspect of life as it normally occurs. When young, we have more strength and energy. When old, we have the benefit of experience and accumulated wisdom. Work hours provide a sense of productive satisfaction. Leisure time gives us relaxation and recreation. Sunday Eucharist is an opportunity for communion with God and fellow believers. The rest of the week allows us to put our faith into practice and be dedicated to daily prayer.

Saint Francis of Assisi is well known for his "attitude of gratitude" for all of creation. As part of his conversion, and in the years following it, he became very aware of the many precious ways in which God provided for him. Late in his life, Francis wrote a hymn called "The Canticle of Brother Sun." In this song he praises God for the elements of nature which he saw as loving gifts of God. He was appreciative for the sun and moon, for fire and water, for wind and the earth.

Finally, Francis was supremely grateful for the gift of Jesus' love. Francis felt so grateful to Jesus for all that He suffered for us on the Cross that Francis received the gift of the stigmata (the five wounds of Christ on hands, feet, and side).

While school is out for the summer, vacations begin, nice weather lets us spend more time outdoors, and farmwork keeps many outdoors, we can appreciate Saint Francis' hymn. In the midst of our ball games, fishing, farming, and gardening, we can be aware of the goodness and graciousness of God in providing for us. We can echo Saint Francis: "Most High, all-powerful, good Lord, Yours are the praises, the glory, the honor, and all blessing."
