## Real Live Saints

The formulae for holiness in this All Saints Day gospel are the Eight Beatitudes. Heroic examples of each of the beatitudes can be found in the following popular saints. You may rightly prefer your own choices.

“Blessed are the poor in spirit.” St. Louis of France, St. Elizabeth of Hungary – a king and a queen who cared for the poor.

“Blessed are they who mourn.” The sorrowful Mother, who inspired Michelangelo’s pieta.

“Blessed are the meek.” St. Theresa, the Little flower, saint of The Little Way.

“Blessed are those who hunger for righteousness.” St. Thomas Moore, patron saint of lawyers, a martyr for justice.

“Blessed are the merciful.” St. Lucy, who forgave her executioners.

“Blessed are the clean of heart.” St. Agnes, St. Aloysius, St. Maria Goretti, all young Christians who died rather than compromise their virtue.

“Blessed are the peacemakers.” St. Francis of Assisi, God’s troubadour of peace

“Blessed are those who are persecuted.” St. Joan of Arc, St. Stephen the proto-martyr, St. Lawrence, the deacon.



Too often we think of the saints as aliens from another world. But it is encouraging to know that most of the canonized saints were not monks or missionaries or cloistered nuns, but led lives similar to our own.

St. Isadore was a farmer, St. Conrad was a doorman, St. Elizabeth Ann Seton was a teacher, a nurse, a convert, a mother. St. John Labare was a homeless vagrant, St. Zita was cook, St. Peter Frassati was a soccer star, St. Piere Toussaint was a barber, St. Lucy was a maid, St. Albert was a scientist, St. Gianna Beretta was a mother and a doctor who died in childbirth.

All Saints Day challenges each of us to be a saint by living our ordinary daily life prayerfully in charity and peace — in a word, by living the Eight Beatitudes.
