Today's second reading, so popular at weddings, is developed further by Pope Francis in his recent document, *The Joy of Love*.

*Love is patient.* It does not act on impulse and avoids giving offense in imitation of God's patient mercy with sinners.

*Love is kind.* It helps others, ever ready to be of assistance. Love is shown more by deeds than by words, without asking to be repaid.

*Love is not jealous.* It is never envious, but values the achievements of another and does not see them as a threat to one's own efforts.

*Love is not boastful.* It is focused on others, refraining from speaking too much about oneself, never seeking to be the center of attention.

*Love is not rude.* It is thoughtful, never impolite or harsh. The words of love are pleasing, never abrasive or causing others to suffer.

*Love is generous.* It desires to love more than to be loved. Love transcends the demands of justice, expecting nothing in return.

*Love is not resentful.* Indignation is healthy when reacting to a grave injustice, but is harmful when it dominates our attitude towards others. Love frees and heals.

*Love forgives.* Brooding leads to deep resentment. Forgiveness seeks to

understand another's weaknesses. It knows God's forgiveness.

*Love rejoices with others.* It sees the dignity and value of another's abilities and good works without comparing and competing or secretly rejoicing in their failures. Love celebrates all goodness.

*Love bears all things.* It is able to face whatever might threaten it. It avoids harsh judgment, preferring to cherish the good name of others.

*Love believes all things.* It never presumes that the other is lying or cheating. It does not try to control the other person with a selfish grip. Love does not try to possess and dominate.

*Love hopes all things.* Love does not despair of the future. It trusts that others can change and mature into unexpected beauty and potential. It knows that God can draw some good even from evil.

*Love endures all things.* It bears every trial with a positive attitude, standing firm in adversity, in constant readiness to confront any challenge. Love never gives up, even in the darkest hour.

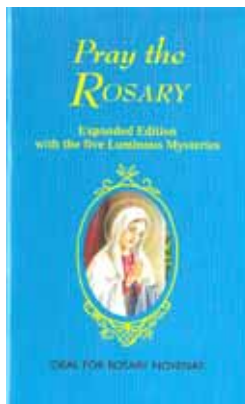

## Raffle to Benefit Hays ARC Park

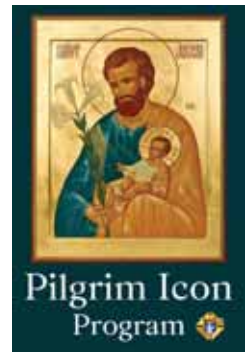
