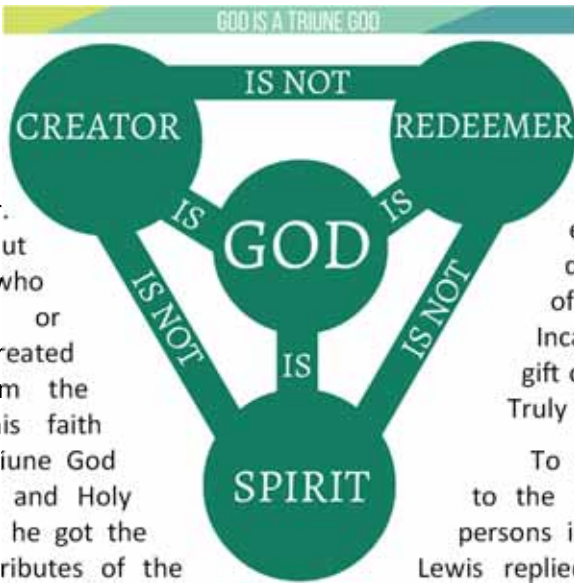
## 3-IN-ONE

Senior parishioners will remember the versatile 3-IN-ONE oil. This once popular and still available product was invented by George Cole in 1894 with the slogan: *cleans, lubricates, protects* — *three-in-one*.

Perhaps Mr. Cole was a devout Christian who consciously or unconsciously created his slogan from the teachings of his faith regarding the triune God of Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. If he did, he got the fundamental attributes of the three rather well, although in the wrong order.

God the Father is the creator who protects his creatures; God the Son is the saving redeemer who cleanses us of our sins; and God the Holy Spirit anoints us with his grace to animate our inner spirit. The Father, Son, and Holy Spirit are Creator, Redeemer, and Sanctifier. Mr. Cole's 3-IN-ONE slogan of *protects, cleans, lubricates* is not too far off the mark, although the theology is somewhat more refined.

The Catholic Catechism explains: "The revealed truth of the Holy Trinity is at the very root of the Church's living faith, beginning at Baptism. It finds its expression in the preaching and prayer of the Church since apostolic writings, such as this salutation used in the Eucharistic liturgy: 'The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all.'"



The Catechism further explains that the three divine persons are united in their work. "Inseparable in what they are, the divine persons are also inseparable in what they do. But each shows forth what is proper to him in the Trinity, especially in the divine fatherhood of God, of the Son's Incarnation and the gift of the Holy Spirit." Truly 3-IN-ONE.

To those who object to the paradox of three persons in one God, C. S. Lewis replied, "Many people are fond of the Christian statement that 'God is love.' But they may fail to notice that the words 'God is love' have no real meaning unless God contains more than one person. Love is something that one person has for another person. If God were a single person, then before the world was created there was nothing to love; He could not love, less be love."

The catechism reminds us, "By the grace of Baptism 'in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit', we are called to share in the life of the Blessed Trinity, here on earth in the obscurity of faith, and after death in eternal light." The Christian belief in the Trinity is not abstract theology, it impacts our life. As Mr. Cole's 3-IN-ONE oil, it is very practical.

### ... and mirth

The mystery of the Trinity, AMEN.
