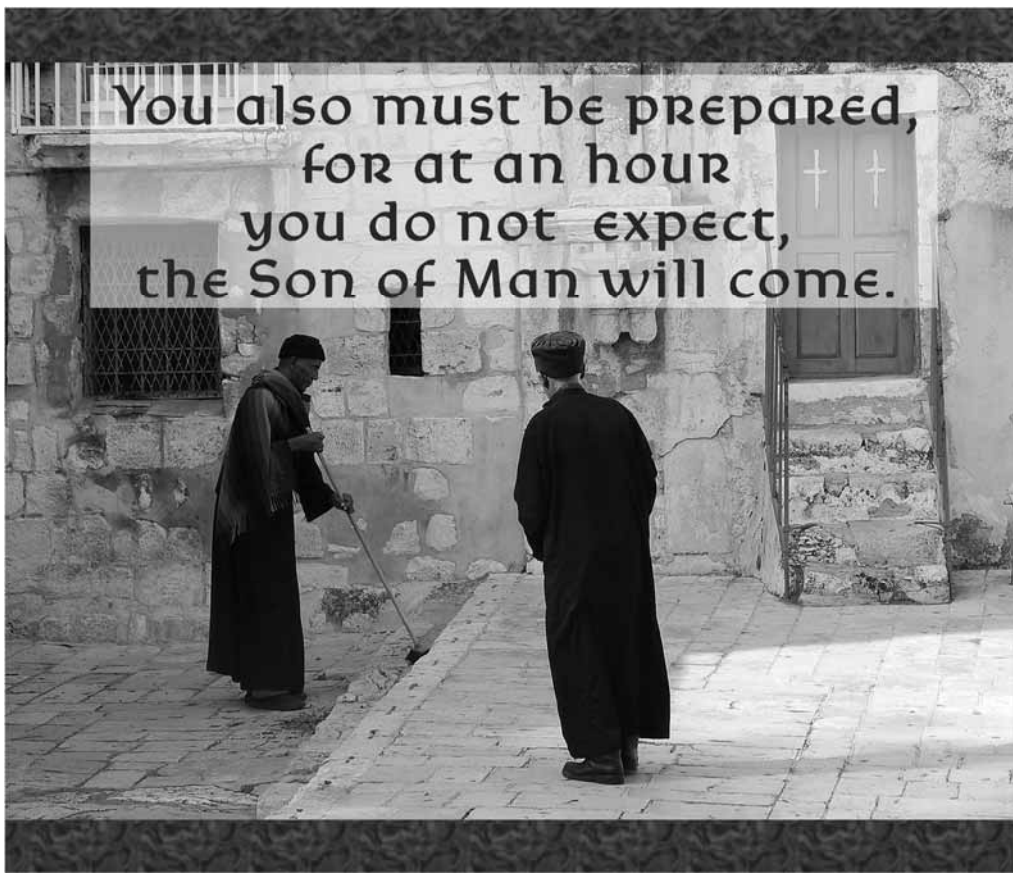

## Moral Responsibility

“More will be demanded of the person entrusted with more.” That verse of today's gospel asks what have I done with all the graces God has given me. In brief, “What kind of person am I becoming?”

This gospel theme is developed in two parables. The first parable of the servants waiting for their master's return, stresses the responsibility of always being prepared. “You must be prepared, for at an hour you do not expect, the Son of Man will come.” Only a character well formed day by day is prepared for the final day.



The second parable is about responsibility for our blessings. “More will be demanded of the person entrusted with more.” We profit from our many blessings when they enrich our character, when we develop moral integrity.

These parables do not focus simply on reward or punishment for individual acts. They are about responsibility for how our conduct has developed our character. Not only about being held responsible, but about becoming responsible. The parables are about what kind of a person I am becoming.

Moral choices are about more than the right or wrong of one action. Each moral decision has an enduring effect on our character. Every moral choice has this implicit question: “Will this action make me more considerate,

compassionate, charitable; or will it make me more selfish, stubborn, cynical. What kind of person will I become?”

Unfortunately, we all make mistakes. Some of the great saints were guilty of serious sin: King David, St. Peter, St. Augustine. The ultimate issue was not that they made mistakes but that they repented of their mistakes and changed their lives for the better. Despite their mistakes, because of their mistakes, they became a better person.

It is true that our eternal destiny is determined by the condition of our soul at our death. But that is easily oversimplified. Life on earth is not a pass-fail test for eternal life. Life here is actually the beginning of eternal life, because we will live in eternity with God as the kind of person we die. With every moral choice, we are sowing seeds for our eternity.

Heaven is not simply a prize for good behavior but a sharing in the eternal life of God to the extent that we have developed the capacity to do so here on earth: some more, some less, some, perhaps, not at all. We live with God in eternity as the person we have become in this life. “What kind of person am I becoming?”

### ... and mirth

# ST. FIDELIS CEMETERY POLICY

(as updated August 1, 2022, by the Cemetery Committee  
and approved August 2, 2022, by the Pastoral Council)

St. Fidelis Parish prides itself in the honor we pay to our beloved departed by keeping our cemetery as neat and clean as possible. In order to be able to keep it in its best shape, as we all want it, everyone concerned must do their part to observe these policies. It is a matter of justice to all and of treating everyone the same. There may be no burials or setting of monuments without an easement or the express permission of the Pastor. When individuals or families pay for a **Plot-Easement** in this cemetery, they have the right to bury family members. An easement is a nonpossessory right to use and/or enter onto the real property of another without possessing it. The cemetery property itself remains that of the St. Fidelis Parish, as well as the obligation to maintain it.

Therefore we must set forth these rules:

1. Items, such as flowers, ornaments, figurines, memorial crafts, solar lights, and hanging poles are not allowed to be placed in or on the ground surrounding monuments. These items will be removed, when we mow next. They may be retrieved from the fenced area south of the cemetery shed. [Note: *Flower arrangements placed in or on the ground for holidays—Memorial Day, July 4th, Labor Day, and All Souls—must be removed within seven days.*]
2. No glass containers are allowed.
3. No spraying of herbicides around monuments by individuals will be allowed.

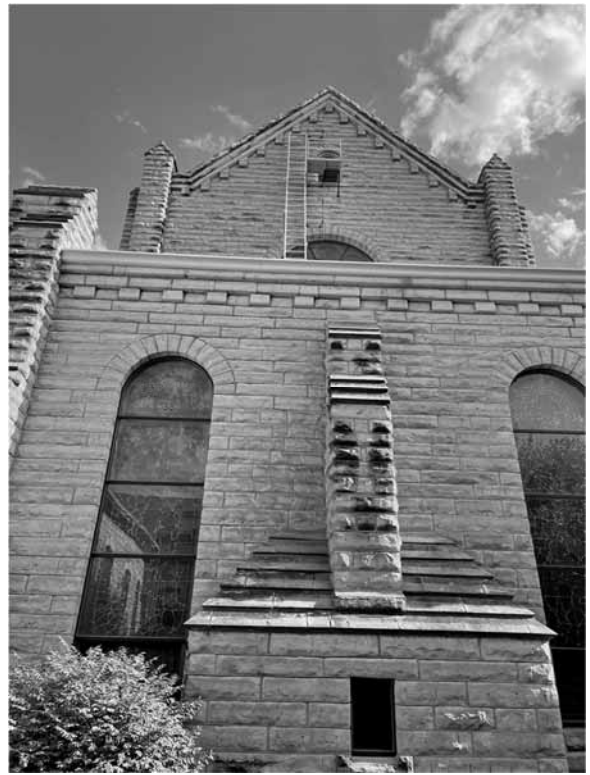

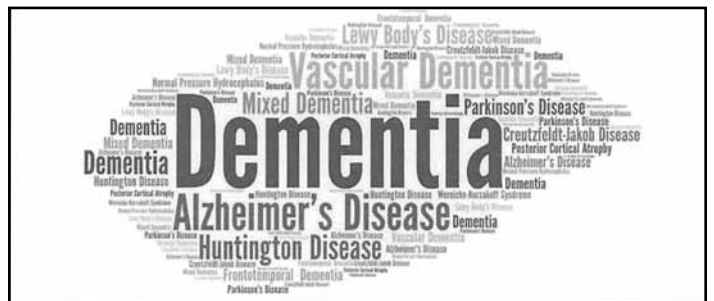
