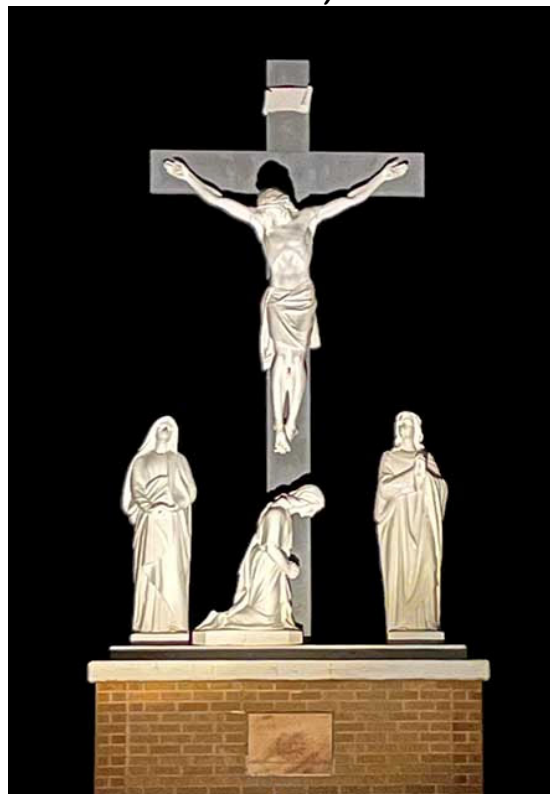

FRIARS' MIND

This Sunday in the Gospel Jesus again lays out the conditions of being a disciple. That is, a true disciple, a true follower of Christ. He says that we should love him more than those people that we love so dearly – more than our families, more than our sons and daughters, more than mom and dad, more than grandma and grandpa, more than our pets. More than our homes, our careers, our accolades, and possessions.

This is a hard truth but, it's a truth that leads us to true discipleship. Again, discipleship is walking in the ways of Christ. Loving Christ more than anything in the world! Above even those who are dear to me. Discipleship is following in his footsteps. Loving how he loves and doing what he does. Jesus says later in the gospel, "whoever does not take up his cross and follow after me is not worthy of me." (Matt 10:38) But again, this is the reality of discipleship which involves a kind of "leaving behind" of our former selves. This is Christian discipleship. It's following Christ because we have realized that there is no other way to live life except by following in his footsteps. Some of the saints, called this endeavor the greatest journey that we could make. The one of discipleship in which we follow after Christ and love him.

In the life of St. Francis, the patron of our Capuchin identity, I believe he lived this out so beautifully because he illustrated this in his life. He viewed discipleship as encountering Christ and then allowing that encounter to shape how we live. For Francis, that discipleship came from the Gospels and so for that reason, he taught the early friars to live the gospel! To walk in humility, to forgive, to serve, to bless, to be a sign of God's love.

Discipleship, for St. Francis, meant that we are to make the Gospel, everything in it, the pattern of how we are to live. And so discipleship is not just someone who speaks about Christ, but its someone whose life becomes a reflection of the gospel, a reflection of Christ himself. Amen!
