We all find ourselves tempted in one way or another, even each day. We are tempted to overeat or to imbibe too much. We are tempted to lash out at real or perceived insults. We get impatient with everyone else's driving. The tendency to selfishness and pride can be strong. In one of their documents, the National Council of Catholic Bishops said, "Every temptation is an invitation to a commitment re-affirmed." A temptation itself is not sinful if we resist it and do not willingly entertain it. But it can be an opportunity to once again choose virtue, moderation, and charity. This can be a help--not just saying No to the sin, but saying Yes to the corresponding virtue. We choose temperance versus gluttony, humility versus pride, charity and respect versus anger and lust.

In the moment of temptation, THINK!

"This thought, word, or deed does not fit my values that I hold dear."

"I know I will regret this thought, word, or deed."

"With the help of Jesus, I will say NO to this thought, word, or deed."

In your mind, and aloud if need be, say NO.

Then get physically away from the situation of temptation.

Repeat these steps as needed.

As well, immediately pray devoutly. Begin some other task. Call someone you trust.

Get further away from the place/person of temptation.

C.S. Lewis, *Mere Christianity*, 1952: "A silly idea is current that good people do not know what temptation means. This is an obvious lie. Only those who try to resist temptation know how strong it is... A man who gives in to temptation after five minutes simply does not know what it would have been like an hour later. That is why bad people, in one sense, know very little about badness. They have lived a sheltered life by always giving in."

Father Francis J. Remler, *How to Resist Temptation*:

Temptations . . . Prove your love for God;

. . . Help you grow in humility;

. . . Through them you can atone for past sins;

. . . Help you grow in love for God;

. . . Help increase your merit and your eternal glory.

In the midst of temptation, may we seek the help of Christ and the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Saint Joseph, and all the holy angels and saints. We can triumph.



Mid-Continental Restoration Co., Inc. will be completing this work. The scope of the project includes:


Sealant Application to Vertical Joints in Stone Caps & Bands

All vertical head joints between coping stones and stone bands will be cut back and cleaned of any loose or foreign debris. These joints will then be resealed with new sealant, tooled to a neat and uniform appearance, and color-matched as closely as possible to the existing material.

Tuckpointing Stone Mortar Joints

All mortar joints will be carefully inspected. Any that are found to be void, open, or defective will be repaired. All affected areas will be cleaned to remove any loose residue, and defective joints will be repointed using a non-staining, non-shrinking Type "N" masonry mortar. This mortar will be color-matched and tooled to blend seamlessly with the surrounding joints.

The total estimated cost for this vital work is **\$109,980**. We are asking for your generosity in helping us raise the necessary funds to complete these repairs. No amount is too small, and all donations are deeply appreciated. You can donate by dropping off at the Parish Office or by placing in the collection basket in a **separate envelope labeled “Building Repairs”**.



LIFT HIGH THE CROSS LENTEN YARD CROSS PROGRAM

Kruse Scholarship - Applicant must be an active registered member of a Catholic parish in the Diocese of Salina. These scholarships are approximately \$500. • Marymount Memorial Educational Trust Scholarship - Applicant must be attending an accredited Catholic College as a full-time student and an active registered member of a Catholic parish in the Diocese of Salina. These scholarships vary but range from \$1,000-\$3,000. • Susie Deges Scholarship - This scholarship is specifically for high school seniors in the diocese who are active in their local CYO (Catholic Youth Organization). This scholarship is \$1,000.


