Awareness

First of all, please pay attention to your driving and your surroundings at all times. Be careful and courteous. Good driving includes routinely looking at all rear-view mirrors and over your shoulder in order to be aware of traffic around you.

AND, if you have just stopped at what will be a long traffic light, without compromising your situation, you might consider this: Glance into the middle rear-view mirror to see the car behind you. Just a quick glance to take in who is there. What do you see? A person who is young or old, alone or with others, are they happy, sad, or angry? Are they honking at me because the light has turned green? Is the driver listening to music with head bobbing and fingers tapping? Is she running fingers through her hair, or is his hand over his face in tired frustration? Is everyone in the car looking at cell phones? Is a young mother trying to settle a restless child? Is an elderly driver trying his best to concentrate in busy traffic? Are people arguing, laughing, chatting, or staring blandly straight ahead? Nowadays, we tend to objectify other drivers. We do not see them clearly through car windows. We think of the shell of the other automobile as an adversary. "That SUV cut me off." "That pickup is tailgating me."

Once, I was frustrated with a sedan that pulled out in front of me when I had the right of way. Soon, we both pulled into the same nursing home parking lot. It was Bill, a man I knew from the parish. It was Bill, whom I knew, not just some sedan. There are real, live people in those vehicles, as I am in mine, and you in yours. We are more than the automobile we drive. By taking a glance at the actual person, when we can do so safely, we humanize one another. We can say a quick prayer for them according to what we perceive in the mirror. If we are not the driver, we can more freely be aware of people in other vehicles. This practice can make us more prayerful, more conscientious, more careful and courteous in our driving, and in our general living.

Let us always, in every situation, be ready to notice one another and pray for one another.

You will notice a new reliquary (holder of a relic) in the Saint Padre Pio cabinet. Rather than continue to use the Padre Pio relic loaned to us from the Padre Pio Foundation, we now have a Padre Pio relic from the archives of the Capuchin Province of Saint Conrad (Denver). Same saint. New relic--still First Class. New look. With this change, all of the donations received in the relic cabinet will go to our Basilica and none of it shared with the Pio Foundation. We will continue the monthly Mass for the intentions placed in the relic cabinet.

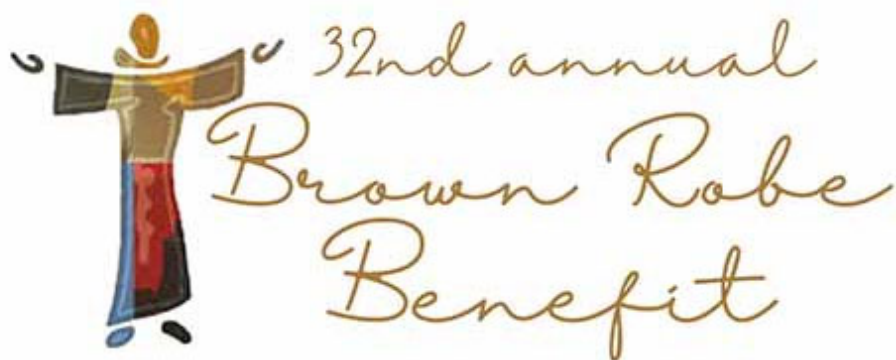
