The Glass Ceiling

Susan Muto, who writes on the spirituality of women, said, "With her Assumption into heaven, Mary broke our *glass ceiling* to salvation." The *glass ceiling* is used by the women's movement to express an invisible barrier to equality for women.

Susan Muto applies this image to

Christian salvation as revealed in Mary. Mary was the first to break the invisible barrier to union with God. We experience many obstacles to Christian's salvation. We know that we were made to live with God, here as well as hereafter. Yet such union with God is seldom realized. There is a barrier, a glass ceiling, preventing us from our Christian ideal.

On the feast of the Assumption of Mary we honor one who has actually achieved the fullness of eternal glory. Mary broke the glass

ceiling for all Christians. In proclaiming the doctrine of the Assumption in 1950, Pope Pius XII said, "Since Mary completely overcame sin by the unique privilege of her Immaculate Conception, which she validated by a sinless life, she was not subject to the corruption of the grave which is a consequence of sin. She did not have to wait until the end of time for the redemption of her body."

This fullness of Christ's victory over sin and death will not be granted to us until the resurrection of the just at the end of time. Mary, who was the first and perfect disciple was rightly the first to share fully in the victory of Christ over sin and death. When she assumed into heaven, body and soul, she broke the glass ceiling of union with God.

Pope Pius XII said that the Immaculate Conception was the basis

for

the

Assumption, since it was her sinlessness that allowed Mary the glory of the Assumption. Mary Immaculate broke the glass ceiling οf salvation, that glass ceiling to salvation is sin. This image has a timely message. The nature of a glass ceiling is that we cannot see the barrier. Sin is invisible in our age. It is very much a reality, but too often we do not see it. We seldom use the

word sin. We call it by other names: addiction, psychosis, weakness, stress.

More than anything else it is our sins which keep us from being happy in this life and unworthy of eternal life. Our failure to see our sins is our glass ceiling to salvation. The Assumption of Mary, in which she broke that glass ceiling, is a promise that we can reach eternal glory and a fuller life here, if we repent of our sins.



RCIA

Each year, many adults are called to join the Catholic faith. How does someone join the Catholic Church? Through a process called the RCIA. Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is the process in which adults become full, participating members of the Catholic Church. Participants, known as catechumens go through a process of studying the Gospel, nurturing their relationship with God, becoming familiar with the Catholic teachings and practices, professing their faith in Jesus and the Church, and receiving the sacraments of initiation: Baptism, Communion, and Confirmation.

Who can join?

The Church extends an invitation to all who wish to become members of the Catholic faith. Those who go through the RCIA process fall under one of the following categories:

- Someone who has never been baptized.
- Someone who is of another faith and wishes to convert to Catholicism.
- An individual who was baptized in another Christian denomination and wishes to become a member of the Catholic faith.
- Someone who was baptized in the Catholic Church, but never received the sacraments of First Communion and Confirmation.

RCIA classes begin on <u>Sunday, September 24, 2023</u>, at the Parish Activity Center in Victoria. If you are thinking about joining the Catholic faith, you are most welcome to join the class. There is no obligation or cost. <u>Please be assured that you will never be quizzed or tested on class material.</u> If you are interested or would like information, please call Father Jim Moster or Shirley Brungardt as soon as possible at 785-735-2777.
