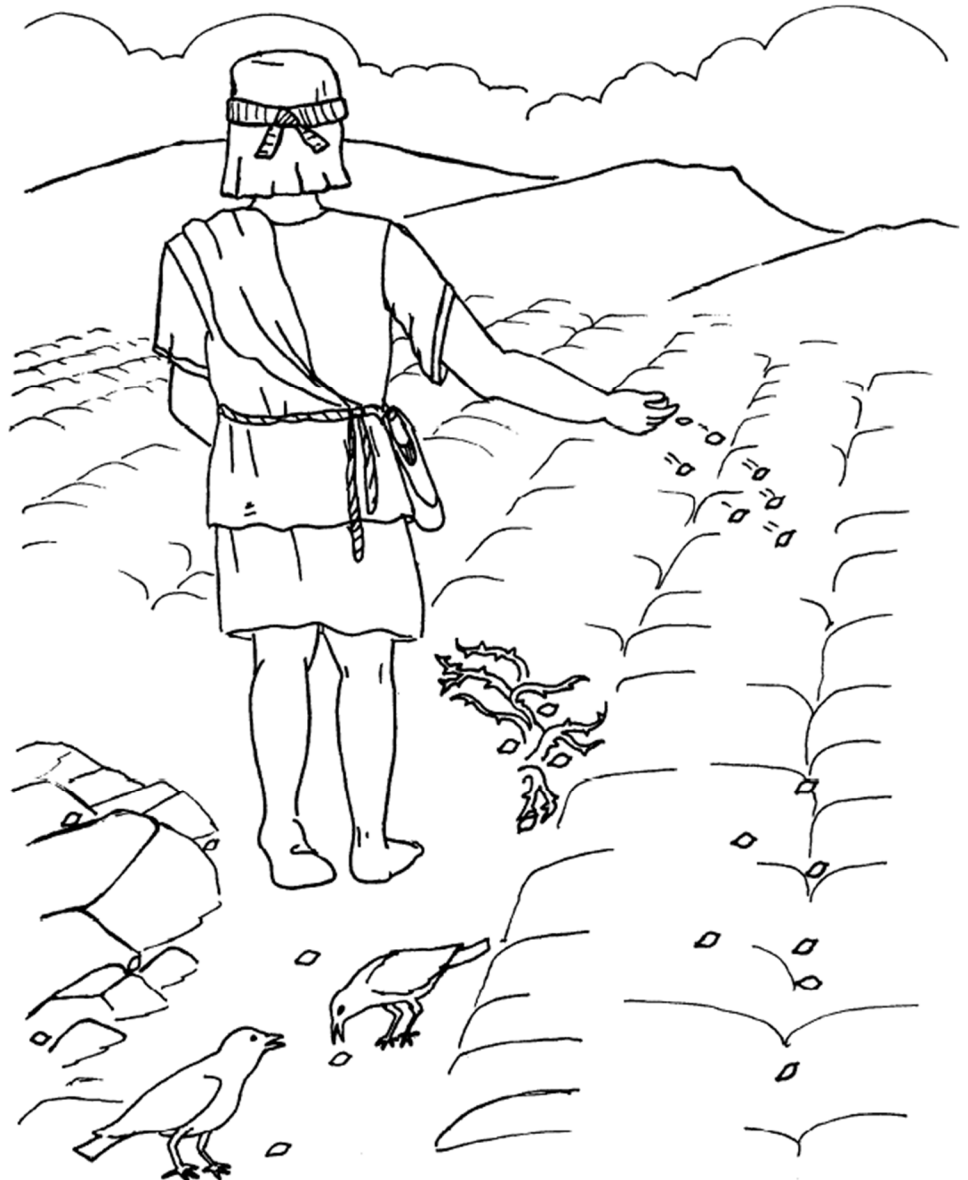

"I like to have a lot of fresh fruit around..."

In these summer months especially, there's nothing like having fresh fruit on a these hot days. As a kid, I remember sliced oranges, apples and of course, watermelon on every family outing. Being in the friary, I noticed that many of the brothers will eat fruit if it's there in front of us, once it's sliced and placed in a bowl.

But there's a truth to that even in our spiritual lives. That the fruits of our lives and our faith might seem to be unreceivable if it isn't prepared well enough. I think that's a common temptation we face. Many of us have tremendous gifts. Fruits of prayer, devotion, and compassion – fruits of having the urge to help or minister, or do more for the community or for the parish! - fruits of sharing faith and spreading the Good News.

Scripture tells us to bear fruit, to share those fruits, and be fruitful. However, what's keeping us from doing that? -- Perhaps, it's the false notion that those, our fruits, must be presentable. That our gifts, our fruits have to be freshly sliced, prepared and placed in a fancy bowl so that they can be received. Not true.

Each of us have fruits to give, each of us have unique gifts of bearing fruit, and in this 15th Sunday of Ordinary time it might start to feel like those fruits are far from extraordinary. This week, we remember Jesus' invitation to begin the work of yielding that plentiful harvest.

That begins by the generous sharing of your gifts. The pouring out of your gifts. Amen.
