And that's a presence that assures all the disciples that even though he's left us, he still, in all his glory, splendor, and authority would be in our midst.

For us today, the Ascension gives us a challenge to not stand still, but to literally GO out and live as witnesses of Christ through compassion, faith, justice, and love. Just as the disciples were sent into the world after watching Jesus ascend, we too are sent to bring light and encouragement to others. Amen!

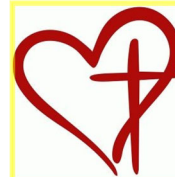

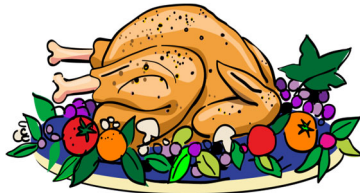

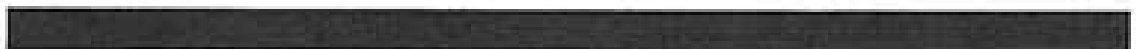
