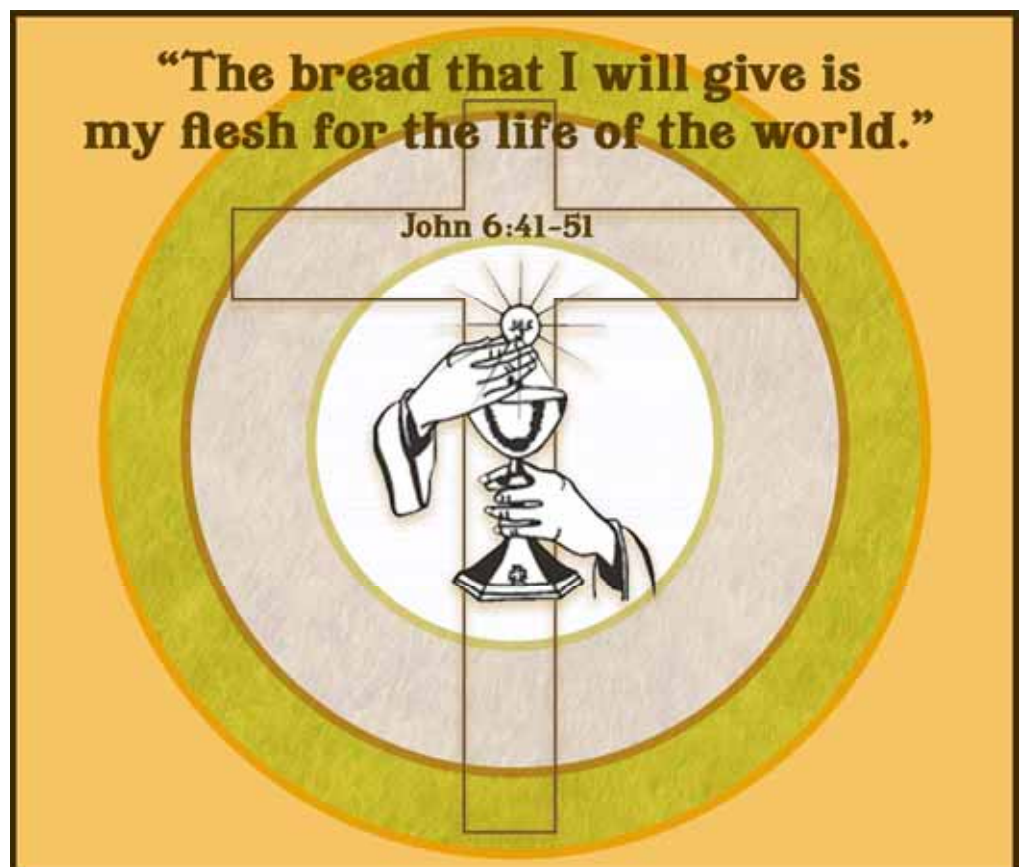

## You Can Live Forever

Some verses in the gospels sound too good to be true. Today's reading from the gospel of John has one of them. In teaching about the Eucharist Christ made this startling promise, "I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever." In those remarkable words Christ referred to himself as bread which will enable us to live forever. Too good to be true?

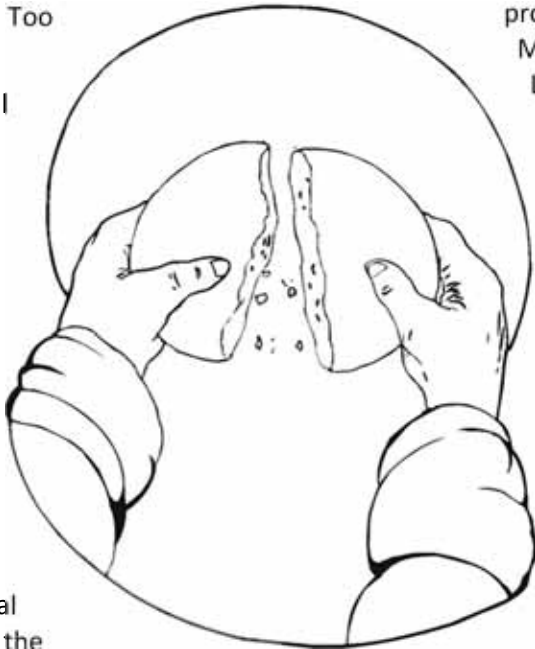
The gospel itself notes the difficulty: the Jewish ancestors who ate manna in the desert died. Manna was a physical bread for a physical life. Yet our Christian ancestors received the Eucharist and they also died. A physical death. But the Eucharist is not physical bread for physical life. The Bread of Heaven is a different bread for a different life.

The life that we receive in the Eucharist, is the life of the Spirit, a share in the life of God. Precisely, it is the life of the risen Christ. St. Paul wrote, "We know that Christ, once raised from the dead, will never die again; death no longer has power over him." (Rm 6:9)

The risen Christ lives forever. The life we share in Holy Communion, the life that is nourished within us by the Eucharist, is the life of the Risen Christ, a life that cannot die. "I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever." The Bread of Heaven

nourishes life that is eternal.

St. Augustine explained when we consume the Eucharist we do not transform it into our life, as we do with ordinary food; rather the Eucharist transforms us into what it is, the life of Christ. When we receive the Bread of Heaven we receive the life of heaven.



An old German proverb says "Was Mann isst, Mann ist." Literally, what you eat, is what you are. The German verbs *to eat* and *to be* have a similar sound. "Was Mann isst, Mann ist." You are what you eat. When we receive the Eucharist, we become what we receive. The Eucharist is not transformed into our mortal life, but the life of Christ transforms our life into life eternal. We become what we receive.

Already in the first century St. Ignatius of Antioch wrote that the Eucharist is "the medicine of immortality, the antidote for death, the food that makes us live forever in Christ Jesus." "I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever."
