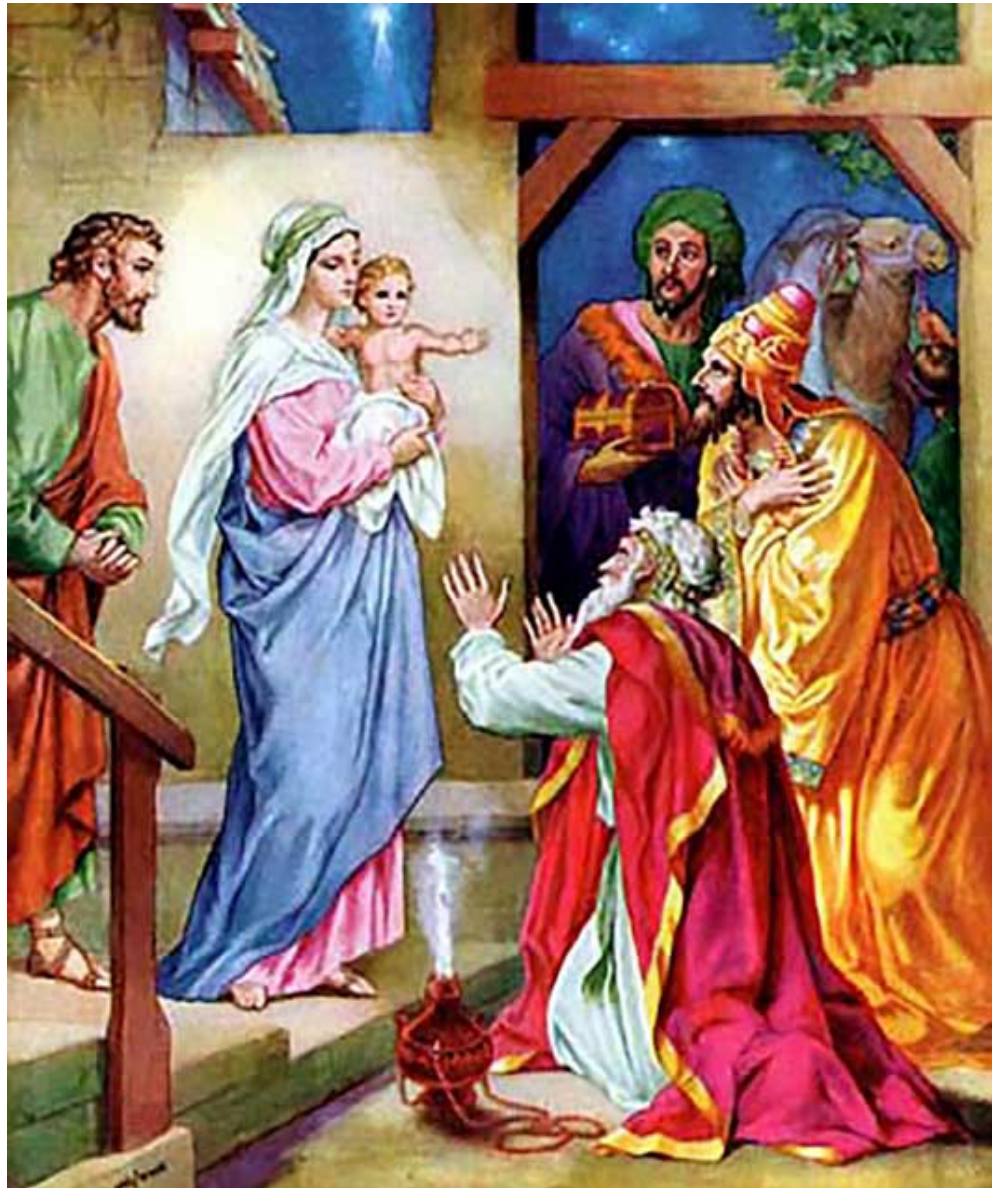

FRIARS' MIND

Fr. Curtis Carlson, OFM Cap.

Our Sunday obligation is a fundamental part of our Catholic living. That means on Saturday at a Mass of anticipation for Sunday, or anytime on Sunday itself. I hope no one truly thinks they are “too busy” for Sunday Mass. That is like saying I am too busy to breathe all day or all week. We can skip breathing for a very short time, but if we skip it any length of time, we die. We can go without food and water for a time, but if we keep up that fasting we will die. If we travel, we still make a point of breathing, eating, and hydrating. If visitors come to our home, we still make a point of breathing, eating, and hydrating. If the kids have many activities, we and they still breathe, eat, and hydrate. If our schedule gets busy and unexpected duties turn up, we still breathe, eat, and hydrate.

We can always attend Mass in any parish rather than our own usual Mass in our usual parish. In Ellis County, there are plenty of opportunities for Sunday Mass. Of course, if we are homebound or seriously sick, we are excused from Sunday Mass. What I am urging is that we not excuse ourselves lightly.

Let us not let the “tail wag the dog.” Sunday Mass is the dog, other things and activities are the tail. It is a matter of Sunday Mass being the highest priority and other things fitting in around it, if possible. It is important that children learn such priorities.

Each week is holy because Sunday is holy. Sunday is holy because the Mass is holy. The Mass is holy because God is with us there: in the people and the priest, in the God’s Word proclaimed, and especially in Holy Communion. We participate in Sunday Mass at least each week for our own good. This active participation with Christ brings us strength, wisdom, and peace.

Sunday Mass, celebrating the Eucharist, is about relationship with God.

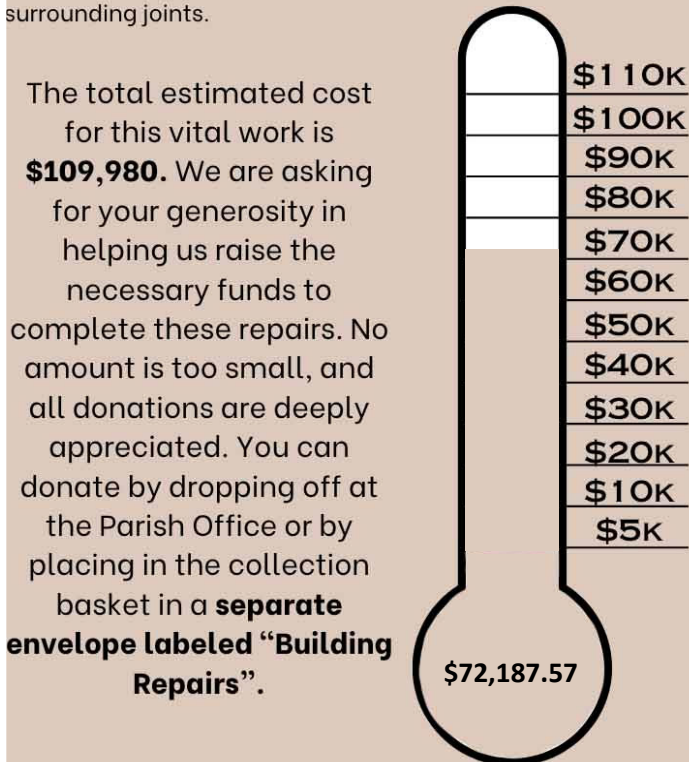
The exterior of our beloved church is in need of repair. This restoration project will help preserve the structure and beauty of our church for generations to come.



Mid-Continental Restoration Co., Inc. will be completing this work. The scope of the project includes:

Sealant Application to Vertical Joints in Stone Caps & Bands
All vertical head joints between coping stones and stone bands will be cut back and cleaned of any loose or foreign debris. These joints will then be resealed with new sealant, tooled to a neat and uniform appearance, and color-matched as closely as possible to the existing material.

Tuckpointing Stone Mortar Joints
All mortar joints will be carefully inspected. Any that are found to be void, open, or defective will be repaired. All affected areas will be cleaned to remove any loose residue, and defective joints will be repointed using a non-staining, non-shrinking Type "N" masonry mortar. This mortar will be color-matched and tooled to blend seamlessly with the surrounding joints.
