## The Mystery of God

The Trinity is a mystery. God in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit is a basic belief of our faith. It is a truth revealed in Scripture, not knowledge that we can derive from human reason. It is a divine revelation about the inner life of God that our limited minds will never fully understand. It is a mystery.

That may frustrate some, but a mystery is more than an unsolvable problem. It has a deeper meaning.

A mystery is a pattern of life that invites a reflection about our own life.

Christian faith is essentially a mystery: the Paschal mystery, the Eucharistic mystery, the mystery of the Trinity. These mysteries tell us something about God, but also something about ourselves. They are patterns of divine life that offer new insights into our life.

The Trinity is a mystery about God. St. Augustine offered this theological analysis: God is three persons since the eternal thought of God the Father is personified as the Son, the Word of God; and the Holy Spirit is the personification of the love of the Father for the Son. These two divine processes—thought and love—relate the Trinity to human life.

Since we are made in the image and the likeness of God, the Trinity is also a mystery about ourselves. Those two processes which Augustine saw in God — thought and love — are the two defining qualities of human life. We can think and we can choose. We have intellect and will. We are made in

the image of God, the triune God.

The Trinity is a mystery not only about our individual lives, but also our life with others. As divine life involves the personal relationships of Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, we are social creatures who relate to others. These relationships are often the most challenging aspect of human life. The peaceful inner life of the Trinity is a model for our human challenge to live harmoniously with others.



The most profound human aspect of sharing in the mystery of the Trinity is living in a rewarding relationship which reflects the image of the Triune God. On a human level we can share in that divine experience, the experience that successful relationships lift us into something bigger and better than ourselves.

Today Christians celebrate the mystery that God is Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, Three persons, equal in majesty, undivided in splendor, yet one Lord, one God. We were created in the image of that Triune God whose life and love we are called to imitate.

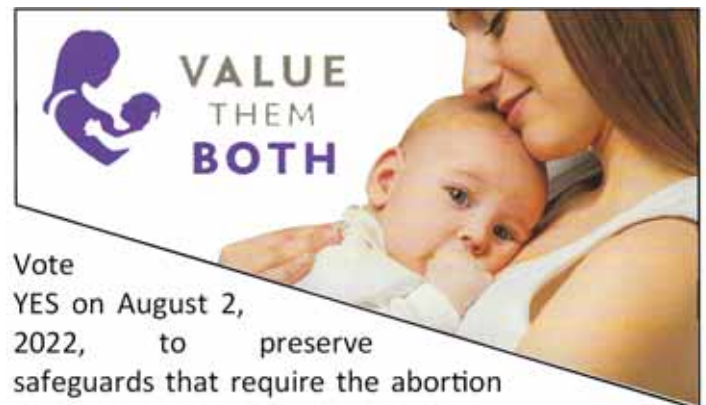

## 25<sup>th</sup> Jubilee Year of First Profession of Vows for Sister Mary Elizabeth Brungardt CP Passionist Nuns of Ellisville (Missouri)

Sister Mary Elizabeth Brungardt CP was born and raised in Ellis County, Kansas. She is the daughter of Margaret Brungardt of Victoria and the late Dr. Joe Brungardt. She was a member of the Basilica of St. Fidelis Parish and graduated from Fort Hays State University in 1992 and Webster University in 1995.

She entered the Passionist Nuns of Ellisville on July 22, 1995, made her first profession on July 23, 1997, and made her final profession of vows on June 11, 2003.

She and her fellow Passionist nuns will celebrate her anniversary (and the 75-year anniversary of the Passionist Nuns presence in St. Louis) with Holy Mass on Saturday, July 23, 2022, at 7:30 a.m. in the Immaculate Conception Monastery Chapel, followed by a reception in the monastery's visitor parlor.

The Passionist Nuns of Ellisville have been making the hosts used at Mass here at St. Fidelis for many years now.

When asked about her vocation, Sister stated:

"Above all, I love living life in the Paschal Mystery: the Passion/suffering, Crucifixion, Death, and Resurrection of Our Lord Jesus Christ to the Praise of His glory. I have held just about every position in the Monastery, including cook and mistress of the prayer guild and the novitiate. I really love my current duties of vocation directress.

"I am the cloistered Nun who gave testimonial witness before thousands of youth at the Kiel Center in St. Louis when Pope Saint John Paul II was here in 1999. There I made it known that I offered my vocational call for the prayerful intention of bringing a halt to abortions and the culture of death.

"I truly love cloistered contemplative living. God is so good to me and knows I love the joys of simple living which are plentiful in the cloister. For me these joys include nature walks, fellowship, and historical and hagiographical books. Most especially, I enjoy praying for YOU."
