#### **Marriage and Mercy**

"Unless the marriage is unlawful." That phrase in today's gospel is known as the exceptive clause, an exception to the prohibition of divorce. In the gospels (Mk 10:2, Mt 19:3, Lk 16:18) Jesus forbids remarriage after a divorce, but in this passage (Mt 5:31) he allows a marriage that is not valid to be annulled.

The teaching of Christ on divorce surprised his audience. He insisted on the



permanent commitment of marriage as the design of God (Gen 2:24). He condemned remarriage after divorce, not divorce itself. And he gave women the same rights and obligations as men. "Whoever divorces his wife and marries another commits adultery against her; and if she divorces her husband and marries another, she commits adultery." (Mk 10:11) Same rights, same obligations.

In modern society many people have difficulty with the gospel ideal of marriage. Some are trapped in destructive marriages through little or no fault of their own. Pope Francis was sensitive to such difficult situations in his letter on Christian marriage, Amoris Laetitia, The Joy of Love. He upheld the ideal of a permanent commitment but cautioned against rash judgement of those in difficult relationships.

Pope Francis emphasized that divorced and remarried people are not excommunicated. "They are members of the church and must be welcome in their parish. Not all situations are of the same moral gravity. The church acknowledges situations where for serious reasons, such as the children's upbringing, a man and woman cannot satisfy the obligation to separate."

"The divorced and remarried, however, should ask themselves whether or not they made attempts at reconciliation; what has become of the

> abandoned party; what consequences the new relationship has on the family, the community of the faithful, and young preparing people marriage."

> "These imperfect realities of modern families and marriages are known

to the mercy of God. Seeing things with the eyes of Christ means not only caring for those in happy and healthy families but also for those who are coping with difficult circumstances. While clearly stating the Church's teachings, we should avoid judgments that ignore the complexity of human situations. For the sake of truth, we obliged to exercise careful discernment in the situations of others."

"Mercy is the consistent theme of Christ. No one can be condemned for ever, because that is not the logic of the Gospel! Here I am not speaking only of the divorced and remarried, but of everyone, in whatever situation they find themselves."

Lent is a time of grace and renewal for the entire Church, especially for the catechumens and candidates preparing for initiation during the Easter Triduum. The three traditional ascetical practices of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving are important pillars for a faithful experience of Lent.

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics (for those age 18 until age 59). In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence from eating meat (for those age 14 and over). When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal.


