

# "Serene Acceptance"

"What a precious privilege that we can go to the Mercy-seat with the assurance that if we ask aright our petitions will be granted. How do people live without Christ and a Mercy-seat? What can they do when suffering anxiety, grief, or bereavement, if they cannot go to Jesus with their sorrows? Precious Saviour, what a refuge in time of trouble, what a joy to carry everything to God in prayer" (Days on the Road: Crossing the Plains in 1865: The Diary of Sarah Raymond Herndon, p. 65) [July 20, 1865].

The Mercy-Seat refers to the solid-gold lid of the Ark of the Covenant--the chest which contained the tablets on which the Ten Commandments were written by God. The Mercy-seat represents the presence of God and God's connection to us. As Catholics we have the Blessed Sacrament as our Mercy-seat. Through the Eucharist, Christ gives Himself to us and we give ourselves to Him. Christ shows His love for us. We show our love for Him when we receive Communion worthily and when we worship Him reverently in Eucharistic Adoration. We offer our "anxiety, grief, or bereavement" to Christ.

American author Flannery O'Connor wrote about passive diminishment: "the serene acceptance of whatever affliction or loss no effort can change." I dare say, for all of us, there has been, and will be, 'affliction or loss that no effort can change.' Loved ones die. We may experience ongoing sickness, chronic pain, and/or a weakening of body and mind. Earthly death WILL happen. We cannot change that. "Serene acceptance" is not "suffering is fine, no problem." But we accept reality as reality, and detach. What is, is. No use agonizing over what, in fact, is. It is a waste of energy. It is a distraction from greater values in life. Even as we suffer affliction, even as we grieve, yet what are we grateful for? What do we value as worthwhile? Where is Christ present to us? How is He embracing us upon the Mercyseat?

Advent—Not just a countdown to Christmas


This Advent, we can learn to wait well together as a parish.


# **Another Opportunity** to be "Pilgrims of Hope" during this Jubilee Year

Mid-Continental Restoration Co., Inc. will be completing this work. The scope of the project includes:

#### Sealant Application to Vertical Joints in Stone Caps & Bands

All vertical head joints between coping stones and stone bands will be cut back and cleaned of any loose or foreign debris. These joints will then be resealed with new sealant, tooled to a neat and uniform appearance, and colormatched as closely as possible to the existing material.

Tuckpointing Stone Mortar Joints

All mortar joints will be carefully inspected. Any that are found to be void, open, or defective will be repaired. All affected areas will be cleaned to remove any loose residue, and defective joints will be repointed using a non-staining, non-shrinking Type "N" masonry mortar. This mortar will be color-matched and tooled to blend seamlessly with the surrounding joints.

The total estimated cost for this vital work is \$109,980. We are asking for your generosity in helping us raise the necessary funds to complete these repairs. 


