ASH WEDNESDAY—FEBRUARY 14

Lent is a time of grace and renewal for the entire Church, especially for the catechumens and candidates preparing for initiation during the Easter Triduum. The three traditional ascetical practices of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving are important pillars for a faithful experience of Lent.

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics (for those age 18 until age 59). In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence from eating meat (for those age 14 and over). When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal.

Mardi Gras and Shrove Tuesday

Mardi Gras is regarded today as an opportunity for one final indulgence before the penitential season of Lent. Christianity has no difficulty with celebrating the good things of life. But long before the day preceding Lent was *Mardi Gras*, it was known as *Shrove Tuesday*. A proper understanding of both titles helps one to prepare better for Lent.

Mardi Gras, literally, Fat Tuesday, implies excess and indulgence. The origin of the term is quite different.



The final days before Lent were once a time to clean out the pantry of the rich food that was forbidden during Lent. Food that would spoil during the forty days of Lent had to be consumed. So the Tuesday before Lent became *Mardi Gras*, Fat Tuesday. Items like pancakes and doughnuts and funnel cakes were popular, hence the pancake races.

Shrove Tuesday, the more traditional title for this special Tuesday, can help to put a better perspective on *Mardi Gras*. It might even correct our excesses. *Shrove Tuesday* means Confession Tuesday. To be shriven means to be absolved of one's sins in the Sacrament of Penance. *Shrove Tuesday* was the day to go to confession and accept the penance that one would do for Lent to atone for past sins. The Sunday, Monday, and Tuesday before Lent are

traditionally known as *Shrovetide*, a time to reflect on our sinfulness and determine what Lenten penance would atone for those failings and help to strengthen our character.

Shrovetide invites Christians to prepare for the coming season of Lent. Proper planning is every bit as important as faithful observance. But human nature tends to avoid a serious confrontation with our weaknesses. It is easier to wait and to see what Lent brings, take it as it comes. But if we do, suddenly it is Holy Week and we realize that we have not done much of anything for Lent.

The purpose of *Shrove Tuesday*, as well as *Mardi Gras* rightly observed, is to avoid an aimless Lent. This is the day, not Ash Wednesday, when we should determine what kind of Lent we will have. Ash Wednesday has its own message. *Mari Gras*, Fat Tuesday, is the day to clean out the food pantry. *Shrove Tuesday*, Confession Tuesday, is the day to clean out the pantry of the soul, to acknowledge harmful habits that can diminish our life, and to remedy them with effective Lenten penance.

Enjoy a festive *Mardi Gras*. But also find a few quiet moments for a sober *Shrove Tuesday*. Your Lent will be more rewarding.

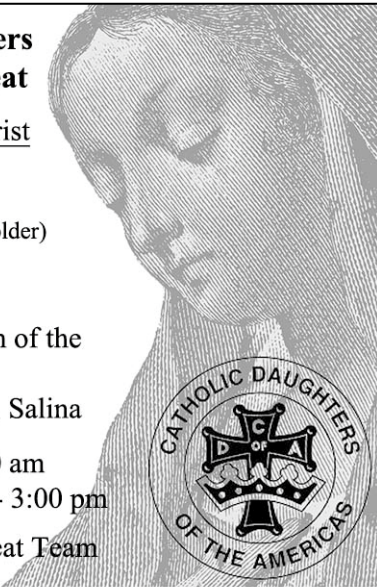
