## Happy Thanksgiving



“Come, share your master’s joy.”  
Matthew 25:14-30

## Thankful for Faith

On Thanksgiving Day we traditionally read the gospel of the ten lepers who were cured by Christ. Only one, a Samaritan, returned to give thanks. That Samaritan leper is offered as a model for our gratitude on Thanksgiving Day. The other nine lepers are a reminder of how often we fail to be grateful for our blessings.

On Thanksgiving Day the media will remind us to be thankful for our many blessings. We have more than enough to eat, while so many go hungry. We have comfortable homes, while many go homeless. We have good health care for our illnesses, while many are afflicted with no hope of proper care. These many blessings are for our material wellbeing.

We also have intangible human blessings for which to be thankful: family and friends, freedom and liberty, education, culture, the arts. These enrich us as human beings. Today we are also thankful for those blessings which make us more human. When the Samaritan leper took the time to return and give thanks he became a grateful person, a better person, a more human person.



But the gospel story does not end there. Christ then points out the most important reason for the leper to be thankful. "Stand up and go, your faith has saved you." He was to be thankful for the gift of faith. And we pause today to thank God for our faith, a faith that enriches our life, a faith that



makes us not only a more human person, but a more spiritual person, a disciple of Christ.

We are thankful for the graces we have received that enabled us to rise above our human weakness and follow, however imperfectly, the way of Christ. For the grace to help those in need, when we were tempted to be selfish. For the grace to forgive those who hurts us, when we were tempted to revenge. For the grace to pray, when we were tempted to despair. For the grace to serve, when we would rather be served. For the grace to be loyal to family and friends.

To express thanks for good food, good health, and good friends you need not come to church. You can do that during half time, sated with a full meal, while you nap in your easy chair. To thank God for the graces which have made us not only more human but more Christian, that we do better in a church pew. We celebrate these blessings best in the Eucharist, the memorial of the death and resurrection of Christ. The word, *Eucharist*, means *Thanksgiving*.
