

Op Art

Op art is two-dimensional, but appears 3-dimensional, even multi-dimensional.

You look at these drawings intently, but somewhat unfocussed. Then a 3-dimensional image emerges. Similarly with other art forms, or with scenery, or with a person, as we behold them, we see them anew.

The Eucharist begins as two-dimensional bread and wine. The bread comes from the cupboard and the wine from the refrigerator. Then a change happens during the Consecration Prayer during the Mass. If we look intently, but somewhat unfocussed, then a multi-dimensional element emerges. We see differently. We look not merely with physical eyes, but with eyes of Faith. We look with mind and heart. We look with yearning, with desire for insight and union.

We behave differently inside of a church. We are quiet and prayerful. We anticipate and slip into the routine of the Eucharistic liturgy. "In the liturgy of the Mass we express our faith in the real presence of Christ under the species of bread and wine by, among other ways, genuflecting or bowing deeply as a sign of adoration of the Lord. 'The Catholic Church has always offered and still offers the sacrament of the Eucharist [for] adoration, not only during Mass, but also outside of it, reserving the consecrated hosts with the utmost care, exposing them to the solemn veneration of the faithful, and carrying them in procession." (Catechism 1378).

May God grant us the perception to see and recognize His Presence in the Eucharistic Body and Blood. May we worship Him in awe and wonder and gratitude. And may we live in such a way as to be worthy to receive Him.
