Our tri-parish community rose to the call of our Bishop Gerald Vincke last year. He wanted parishes with no extended hours of Eucharistic Adoration to set up such hours. He wanted parishes already having extended hours of Eucharistic Adoration to add more hours.

St. Fidelis: Formerly, we had 2 hours weekly or 104 hours per year. We began extended hours of Adoration on June 24, 2026. We had 50 weeks (closed Christmas and Thanksgiving weeks) during the last year. 72 hours x 50 is 3,600 hours. Minus 12: closed on Holy Thursday. So, 3,588 hours total during the past year. 82 parishioners are regularly scheduled adorers, often as teams of husband/wife or family. Many regulars have more than one scheduled time per week. We have 16 faithful substitutes.

St. Boniface had three 24-hour periods of adoration, one in each of July, December, and February. Then an 8-hour period in June. Total 80 hours.

St. Ann: 139 hours available during last year. An average of 9 people attended each week, some attending multiple hours = 1213 people-hours last year.

Saint Padre Pio (whose relic is with us at St. Fidelis Basilica) said "A thousand years of enjoying human glory is not worth even an hour spent in sweetly communing with Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament."

Francis of Assisi said: "In this world I cannot see the Most High Son of God with my own eyes, except for His Most Holy Body and Blood. . . . Let us love God and adore him and offer him praises by day and by night."

We see the Eucharist, but it still takes Faith to believe the Eucharist is Christ. But we do believe, because Christ himself said so, because of all those saints and Faithful who do believe, and because Christ established the Church to teach us so.

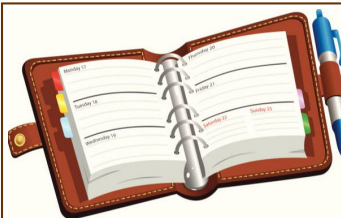
HERZOGFEST BOOTH
