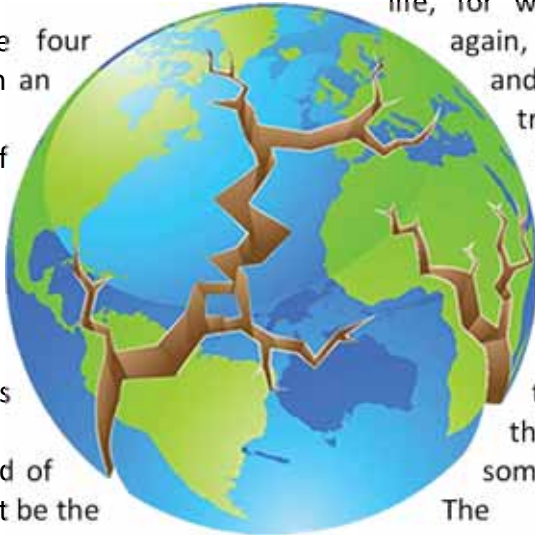
Not the End of the World

Today's gospel about "earthquakes, plagues, and awesome sights in the sky," is not an historical or scientific prediction of the end of the world. It is a form of apocalyptic literature, as found in the Book of Daniel and the Book of Revelation, an allegory of the struggle between good and evil with the promise that goodness will ultimately triumph. It is Scripture in the genre of *Lord of the Rings* or *Star Wars*.

Each of the four gospels has such an apocalyptic description of the end of the world. We read those passages at the end of each liturgical year with this paradoxical message: the end of the world will not be the end of the world.

The concept of the end of the world has multiple meanings: the collapse of the cosmic universe; the moment of one's death; and those tragic moments when our lives become unraveled. The gospel message to each of those: "The end of the world will not be the end of the world."

Apocalyptic scripture is not despair or fear of the future. It was written to instill hope and courage in the present struggle. These passages were written during the persecution of the early Church to assure Christians that this oppression was not the end of their community of faith, the Church.



The Second Vatican Council said: "We do not know the time of the end of the earth and of humanity. Nor do we know how all things will be transformed. The shape of this world, now deformed by sin, will pass away. And God is preparing a new dwelling where justice will abide. Meanwhile during the time that is left, we are to nurture human dignity, freedom, peace and all that is good in this life, for we will find them

again, but free of stain, and transfigured." (GS no. 39)

The end of the cosmic world will not be a disaster, but a fulfillment, a transformation of this world into something greater. The promise of apocalyptic scripture is that in every struggle between good and evil, goodness will ultimately triumph because God is good, loving, and faithful.

Whether your present anxiety is the collapse of the cosmic world, or our cultural world or your personal world the message of the gospel is this: God is good. Divine goodness will triumph over all evil. Every cosmic ending will be the beginning of something greater. "The end of the world will not be the end of the world."
