

Consider our use of the word Hate. We might say we hate winter because of the cold, or we hate brussels sprouts because we do not like the taste. This can be a way of expressing our definite dislike for such things. Yet, we need to be careful not to hate any person, or group of people. We might not like a given person or group of people, but as Christians we cannot be haters.

In *1 John 4:19-21*, we read, "We love because he first loved us. If anyone says, 'I love God,' but hates his brother, he is a liar; for whoever does not love a brother whom he has seen cannot love God whom he has not seen. This is the commandment we have from him: whoever loves God must also love his brother."

If we have God's love within us and desire to love God more and more, then we will not be the kind of person who hates other people. Certainly, God's love in us makes us firm in our values. For example, as Catholics, we are against abortion, but we are not to hate those who support it. Rather, we are to be merciful to them and help them to learn and grow and make better choices. Choosing hate will lessen the love in our lives—the love we will receive from others, and the love we experience within ourselves, and the love we are able to offer to other people.

When we allow ourselves to hate others, we let them have power over us. Our hate hurts us, rather than hurting them. Hate is a poison that we ourselves drink, thinking others will feel it.

St. Francis of Assisi said, "A servant of God cannot know how much patience and humility he has within himself as long as he is content. When the time comes, however, when those who should make him content do the opposite, he has as much patience and humility as he has at that time and no more."

When faced with unfairness, our true nature comes out. We only need patience when our patience is tested. Without that testing, our patience is not strengthened. It is easy to love someone who is lovable. It is difficult to love someone who is unlovable. Perhaps it is even humanly impossible to love someone who is rude or unpleasant, but not divinely impossible. With God's love within us, we can treat every person with patience and courtesy and respect—even if we do not particularly like the person, even if that person continues to be angry, rude, and/or unpleasant.

If we love God truly, then we will love people more. If we are open in loving our neighbor more, in Christ's name—then our love for God will grow as well. So, let us receive God's love and be grateful for that love, and more and more share that love with others.


The exterior of our beloved church is in need of repair. This restoration project will help preserve the structure and beauty of our church for generations to come.

Mid-Continental Restoration Co., Inc. will be completing this work. The scope of the project includes:

Sealant Application to Vertical Joints in Stone Caps & Bands
All vertical head joints between coping stones and stone bands will be cut back and cleaned of any loose or foreign debris. These joints will then be resealed with new sealant, tooled to a neat and uniform appearance, and color-matched as closely as possible to the existing material.

Tuckpointing Stone Mortar Joints
All mortar joints will be carefully inspected. Any that are found to be void, open, or defective will be repaired. All affected areas will be cleaned to remove any loose residue, and defective joints will be repointed using a non-staining, non-shrinking Type “N” masonry mortar. This mortar will be color-matched and tooled to blend seamlessly with the surrounding joints.

The total estimated cost for this vital work is **\$109,980**. We are asking for your generosity in helping us raise the necessary funds to complete these repairs. No amount is too small, and all donations are deeply appreciated. You can donate by dropping off at the Parish Office or by placing in the collection basket in a **separate envelope labeled “Building Repairs”**.



COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIPS -

Great news for students in the Diocese of Salina! There are three scholarship opportunities available for the 2026-2027 school year. The application process is online and opened on Nov. 1, 2025. Students are encouraged to apply by March 1st, 2026 at givecfds.org/scholarships.

- Monsignor Clement A. Kruse Scholarship - Applicant must be an active registered member of a Catholic parish in the Diocese of Salina. These scholarships are approximately \$500.
- Marymount Memorial Educational Trust Scholarship - Applicant must be attending an accredited Catholic College as a full-time student and an active registered member of a Catholic parish in the Diocese of Salina. These scholarships vary but range from \$1,000-\$3,000.
- Susie Deges Scholarship - This scholarship is specifically for high school seniors in the diocese who are active in their local CYO (Catholic Youth Organization). This scholarship is \$1,000.


