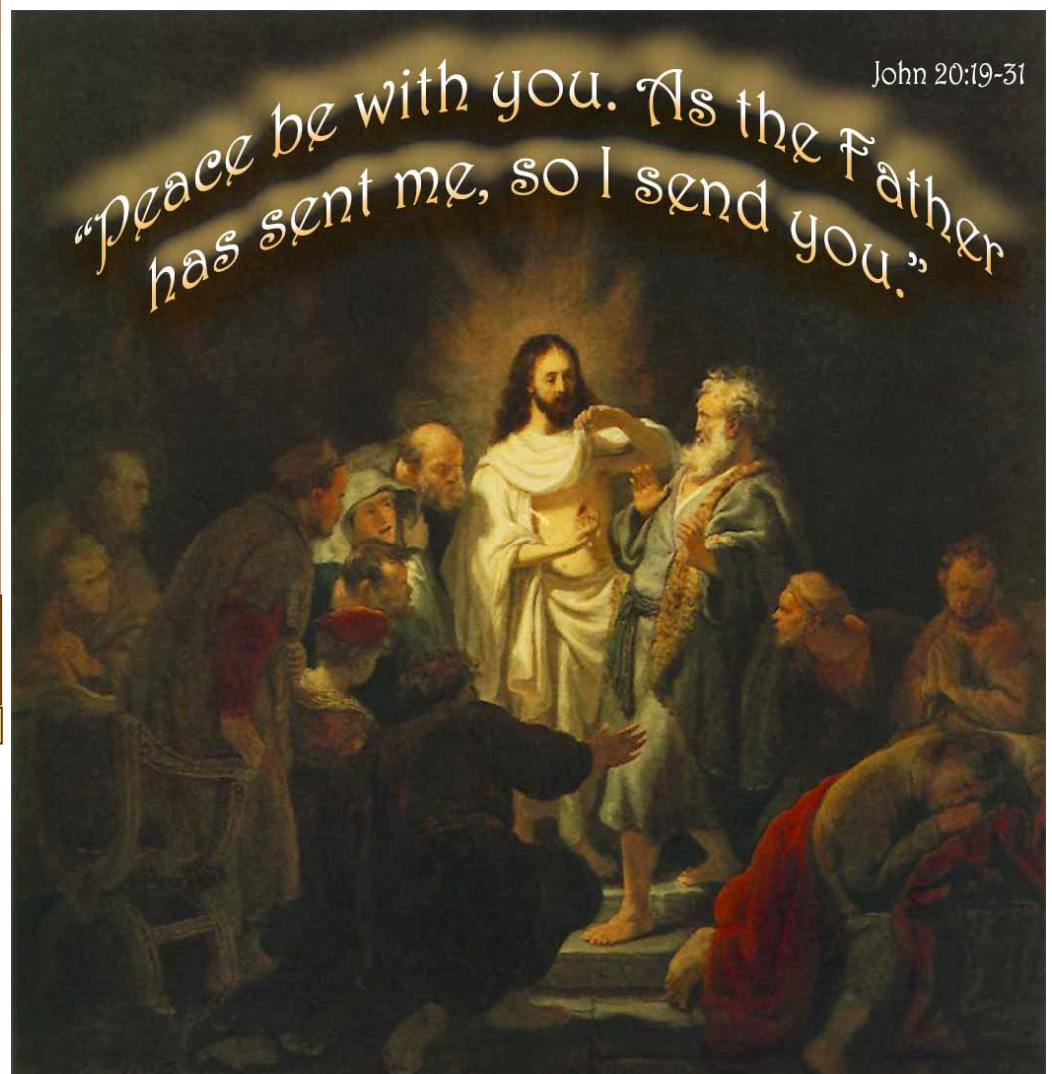

**Third Day:** O God, who chose your servant Pope Francis from among your Priests and endowed him with pontifical dignity in the apostolic priesthood, grant, we pray, that he may also be admitted to their company forever. Through Christ our Lord. Amen.

**Fourth Day:** O God, who in your wondrous providence chose your servant Pope Francis to preside over your Church, grant, we pray, that having served as the Vicar of your Son on Earth, he may be welcomed by him into eternal glory. Who lives and reigns forever and ever. Amen.

**Fifth Day:** Grant, we pray, O Lord, that the soul of Pope Francis, your servant and Priest, whom you honored with sacred office while he lived in this world, may exult forever in the glorious home of heaven. Through Christ our Lord. Amen.

**Sixth Day:** Grant, we pray, almighty God, that the soul of your departed servant Pope Francis, to whom you committed the care of your family, may, with the manifold fruit of his labors, enter into the eternal gladness of his Lord. Who lives and reigns forever and ever. Amen.

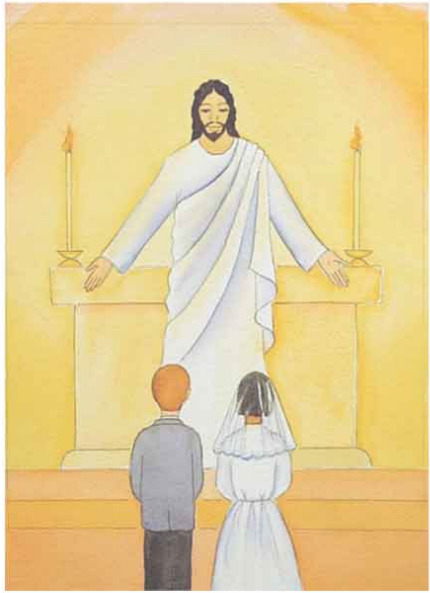

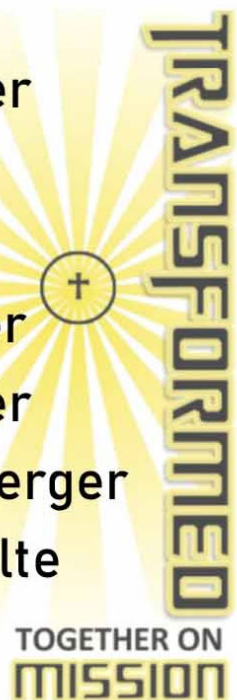


