

#### Pope Leo XIV

Pope Leo XIV (69 year old Robert Francis Prevost) is a member of the Order of Saint Augustine (O.S.A.). He was ordained a priest on June 19, 1982. He served in Peru 1988 to 1999. He was ordained a bishop on December 12, 2014. He became a Cardinal on September 30, 2023. In his inaugural speech, Pope Leo spoke of peace, building bridges, and helping those who suffer.




